HYBRID ALTERNATIVE 4

MASON STREET AS ELEVATED ROADWAY | BROADWAY TO THE FOX RIVER

REPLACE BASCULE AT LOWER ELEVATION

Jughandle ramp included at Broadway. This connection maintains grade separation between Broadway and Mason Street, but requires a full intersection at the Jughandle intersection with Mason Street.

At grade connection to Fox River Trail

Full replacement of Don A. Tillemann Memorial Bridge. To be reconstructed to maximize the area at grade while still maintaining a grade separation over the railroad and Broadway.

Traffic signals warrants will need to be studied at intersection of Broadway and Jughandle Ramp.

Streets to change from One Way to Two Way

No direct access to Playground from Howe Elementary School.
