Project Information

- The Racine Street Bridge was constructed in 1952 and is nearing its service life. While the bridge continues to be safe for use by the traveling public, it is in need of replacement or rehabilitation. A number of rehabilitations and repairs have been made over the years to maintain the bridge, including the replacement of the concrete deck on the approach spans in 1988.
- The bridge is owned by the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT), and is maintained and serviced by Winnebago County and WisDOT engineers. Operators employed by the city of Menasha are responsible for the daily operation of the bridge.
- This project requires an environmental study to document deficiencies in the bridge, develop alternatives for its replacement or rehabilitation, and evaluate the alternatives' impacts on the natural, physical, social and economic environments. The findings of this environmental study will be used to plan and program funding for the reconstruction or rehabilitation of the bridge.
