### Purpose of the meeting


The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is in the process of gathering public input on a proposed improvement along WIS 35 between Pepin and Hager City. We invite you to review the information contained here or on the project website at <a href="https://wisconsindot.gov/Pages/projects/by-region/nw/wis35pepin/default.aspx">https://wisconsindot.gov/Pages/projects/by-region/nw/wis35pepin/default.aspx</a>. Comments received will be documented in the environmental review process. The WisDOT project team appreciates your participation and comments.

### **Project information**

WisDOT is proposing to improve 4.31 miles of WIS 35 from Walnut Street to Pepin/Pierce County Line. Proposed improvements include: milling/removing the top 2.25-inches of the existing pavement, overlaying with 3.75-inches of new asphalt pavement, upgrading beamguard, and applying new pavement marking lines. In addition, select culvert pipes will be repaired.

The asphalt pavement on this section of WIS 35 is showing signs of deterioration in the form of alligator cracking, longitudinal and transverse cracking, pothole patching and rutting. The existing pavement exhibits deficiencies beyond what typical annual maintenance can address. Sections of existing beamguard is in need of repair or replacement.

The environmental process in underway and anticipated to be complete end October 2021. The project has been clears for any impacts to Historical and Archaeological resources.

### **Proposed traffic impacts**

Construction is scheduled to begin on June 2024.

During construction, WIS 35 will remain open to traffic. The project will be using single-lane closures controlled by flaggers for majority of project. Shoulder closures may be required for upgrades to beam guard.

Temporary driveway closures will be necessary during parts of the construction process. WisDOT will contact homeowners and businesses in advance before closing a driveway.

Construction is currently scheduled for completion on August 2024.

#### **Real estate**

No real estate acquisitions are planned for the project.

#### Project update/next steps

This is the first public involvement outreach. A Local Official Meeting is planned for mid-September 2021.


