

Need for Project

- Roadway surface on WIS 118 is deteriorating.
- Some sections of the WIS 118 pavement have settled.
- Several culvert pipes need maintenance.

Proposed Improvements

- Deep mill and overlay WIS 118.
- Conduct additional underlying pavement repairs in settled areas after milling.
- Replacing one culvert and rehabilitating several other culverts.
- Paving side road approaches.
- Refreshing gravel shoulders and emergency turnouts.

Property Impacts


- Project expected to be constructed within existing right of way.
 - No real estate is anticipated to be acquired.
- Temporary driveway closures will be necessary during parts of the construction process.
 - Will coordinate with property owners during these periods.

Traffic Management During Construction

- Construction currently is scheduled for summer of 2021.
- WIS 118 will be closed to through traffic and detoured.
- WIS 118 will be open to local traffic.
 - Motorists can expect to encounter lane closures and flagging operations.
- WIS 118 may be closed in both directions for culvert construction.
 - These closures are anticipated to last 2-3 days each.
