

Urban







Project Needs

Deteriorated Pavement

- Original pavement placed in 1936
- Asphalt overlays showing signs of distress

Safety

- Outdated guardrail
- Steep slopes
- Run-off-the-road crashes

Utilities

- Storm and sanitary sewer
- Water main
- Lighting
- Pedestrian/Bike Accommodations
 - Potential shared-use path
 - Potential bike lanes
 - Sidewalk

Project Improvements Rural

- WIS 88 to approx. Mondovi city limits
 - Concrete pavement
 - Widened shoulders
 - Shoulder rumble strips
 - New guardrail
 - Slope regrading





Project Improvements Urban – Riverside Avenue

- Approx. Mondovi city limits to Eau Claire Street
 - Concrete pavement
 - Curb and gutter
 - Potential multiuse path
 - Shifting roadway
 - Southside parking removal





Project Improvements Potential Shared-use Path

Location

- South side of Riverside Avenue
- Benefits
 - Separates pedestrians and bicyclists from vehicle traffic
 - Connects downtown Mondovi with the southern residential part of the city
- Specifications
 - 10-foot wide asphalt pavement
 - 2-foot shoulders





Project Improvements Urban – Eau Claire Street

• Riverside Avenue to US 10


- Concrete pavement
- Curb and gutter
- Potential bike lanes
- Updated intersection at Riverside Avenue and Eau Claire Street
- Sidewalk
- Potential bump-outs





Project Improvements Potential Bump-outs

- Locations/intersections
 - Water Street and Hudson Street
- Create a safer crossing for pedestrians
 - Pedestrians more visible to drivers
 - Shortened crossing length




Traffic Impacts

- Constructed in one year
 - Construction currently planned for summer of 2025
- Detour will be used
 - WIS 88, WIS 121, WIS 93, US 10
 - Provides safer work zones and shorter construction time
- Access will be maintained for residences and businesses along the project
 - Short-term access restrictions



Traffic Impacts Detour





Right-of-Way Needs

- Types of Right-of-Way
 - Temporary Limited Easements (TLEs)
 - Temporary interest; land remains with property owner
 - Permanent Limited Easements (PLEs)
 - Permanent interest; land remains with property owner, but restrictions apply
 - Permanent Acquisition
 - Land is purchased by WisDOT
