

  - Tiffany Creek Bridge (B-17-0015), Boyceville



# Project Purpose and Need

- Purpose:
  - To preserve the function, operation and safety of these bridges
- Need:
  - To address deteriorating bridge decks and perform maintenance on other elements of the bridges




# Proposed Improvements: Bridge


- South Fork Hay River Bridge - B-17-0014:
  - Replacing the deck
  - Making concrete surface repairs to abutments and wing walls
  - Cleaning and painting bearings
  - Completing spot painting of girders
  - Replacing guardrail
  - Completing pavement approach work
  - Replacing pavement markings




# Proposed Improvements: Bridge


- Tiffany Creek Bridge - B-17-0015:
  - Overlay the deck with concrete
  - Replacing joints
  - Making concrete surface repairs to abutments
  - Completing spot painting of girders
  - Cleaning and painting bearings
  - Completing pavement approach work
  - Replacing pavement markings







# Traffic Impacts

During construction, motorists will encounter the following:

- South Fork Hay River Bridge: WIS 79 will be closed, and traffic will be detoured.
  - The proposed detour route is WIS 170, WIS 128 and WIS 64.
- Tiffany Creek Bridge: WIS 79 will be restricted to a single lane controlled by temporary traffic signals.



Original route time: 12 min. Estimated detour time: 25 min.

# Other Impacts


## During construction:

- For both bridges:
  - Access to businesses and residences will be maintained.
- For the Tiffany Creek Bridge project:
  - Access to Boyceville Park will be maintained.
  - Access to WIS 79 from Tiffany Street will be closed.
  - Access to Tiffany Street from WIS 79 will be right-turn only.



# Proposed Improvements: Railroad Crossings

- Improvements are planned at railroad crossings on WIS 79, Center Street and 130<sup>th</sup> Street.
- Some work at the 130<sup>th</sup> Street crossing will result in closure of the street.
  - The proposed detour route is WIS 170 to 1010<sup>th</sup> Avenue.
