

Gearing Up For GREEN BAY RD CONSTRUCTION



WisDOT plans to improve 1.5 miles of WIS 31 (Green Bay Road), between WIS 11 (Durand Avenue) and WIS 20 (Washington Avenue) in the city of Racine and the village of Mount Pleasant.

Final design is nearly complete, utilities are being relocated, and reconstruction will begin in early 2026. This project is a major reconstruction, so work will be completed over two years in order to provide the contractor adequate time to complete the work. The project will be done in two phases to help minimize impacts: WIS 11 to Margery Drive in 2026, and Castle Court to WIS 20 in 2027. Lane closures and intermittent side-street closures are anticipated for this project. Access to businesses and residences will be maintained throughout the project.

Project Improvements

The following corridor updates are planned to improve safety and operations along the roadway:

- Replacing pavement, storm sewers, and upgrading traffic signals
- Constructing medians at unsignalized intersections
- Installing sidewalks for pedestrian and transit access
- · Widening shoulders for bicyclists
- Extending turn lanes and improving sight lines
- Shifting the roadway alignment north of Castle Court to minimize impacts to historic church properties


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
