

## Wisconsin Department of Transportation WIS 60 Resurfacing - Wayside Drive to I-41 Interchange

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing to improve 4 miles of WIS 60 in Washington County.

The purpose of this project is to address deteriorating pavement condition and decreased ride quality on WIS 60, to assess multimodal accommodations along the corridor, and to upgrade the traffic signals.

## Proposed Improvements:

- 4-inch mill & overlay of WIS 60.
- Replace traffic signals and implement intersection operational improvements at WIS 60/164 intersection.
- Add bicycle and pedestrian accommodations (sidewalks and shared use path). Upgrade curb ramps.
- Repair bridges, replace guardrail, and upgrade storm sewer.

Construction is anticipated to start as early as Fall 2026.
