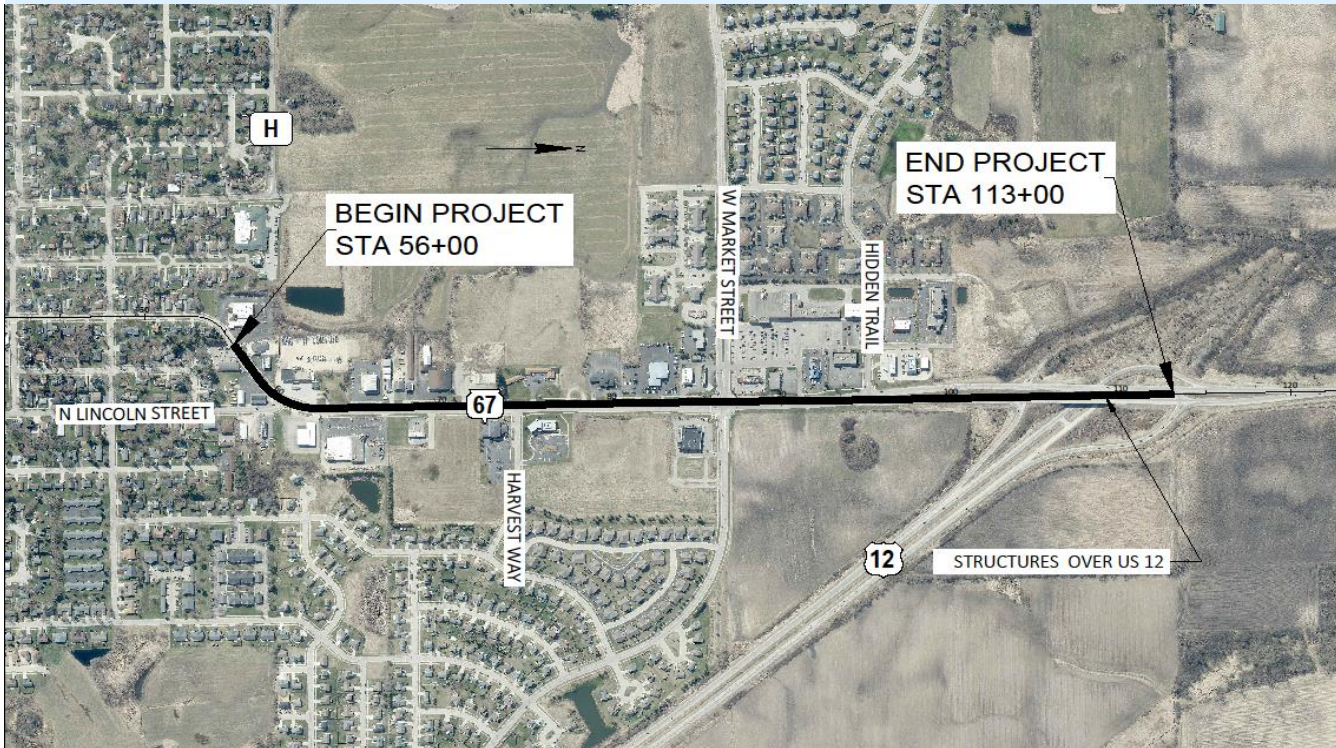
Project Overview

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing to resurface approximately 1 mile of WIS 67 from N. Lincoln Street to US 12 in the City of Elkhorn in Walworth County. The purpose of this project is to provide long-term improvements to the pavement, operation, and safety of the roadway.

Proposed Improvements:

- Resurface the roadway, including pavement repairs
- Road diet (lane reduction) N. Lincoln Street to Market Street (Pavement Marking only)
- Replace the traffic signals at Market Street
- Upgrade curb ramps to American with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards
- US 12 bridge repairs and deck sealing with beam guard upgrades

Schedule

This project is currently in design. Construction is anticipated to start in summer of 2031 and could advance to 2029 if funding is available.



Road Diet

A traffic analysis shows that a lane reduction from 4 to 2 lanes between N. Lincoln Street and Market Street would have acceptable operations for today's traffic and future projections. The project proposes to convert the outside lane to a shoulder with bike accommodations by pavement marking revisions.

Traffic Impacts

Traffic control for the project is still being evaluated. Access for local traffic and emergency vehicles will be maintained during construction.

Real Estate

Most of the work is anticipated to occur within the existing right of way. Real estate acquisition will be required at select locations for curb ramps and sidewalk construction. WISDOT will reach out to effected property owners and work with them throughout the design process.
