WIS 67 Resurfacing – I 43 to East Walworth Street, Walworth County


The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing to resurface approximately 1.1 miles of WIS 67, from IH 43 to East Walworth Street in the city of Elkhorn, Walworth County.

Proposed Improvements:

- Mill and resurface approximately 1.1 miles of the roadway, including pavement repairs.
- Replace traffic signals at South Lincoln and West Geneva Street intersection.
- Modify curb and gutter on south side of the intersection due to truck over tracking.
- Update curb ramps to be ADA compliant.
- Coordinate with Wisconsin & Southern Railroad to replace the crossing pavement, signal, and gates.
- Perform minor box culvert maintenance.
