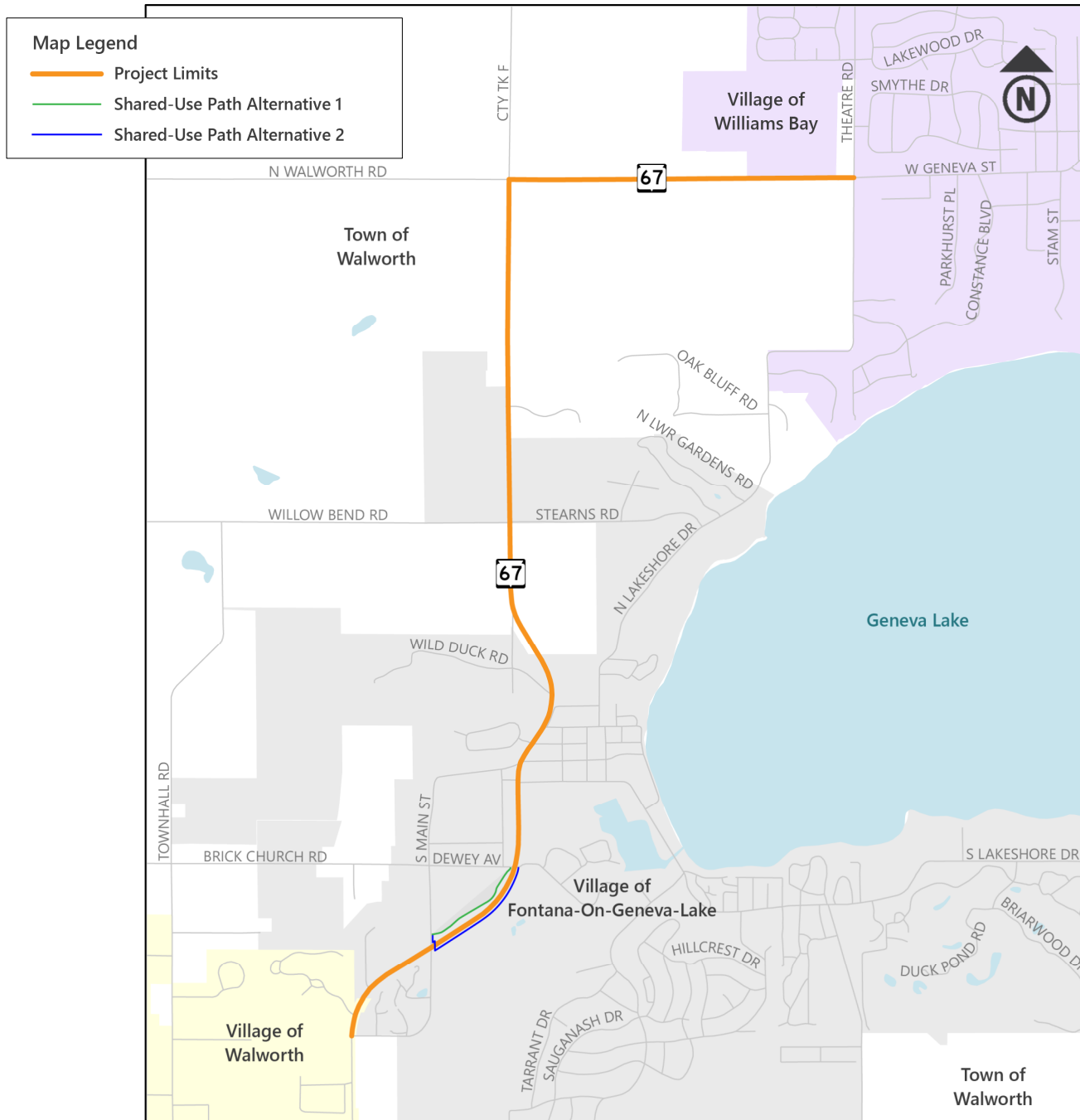

WIS 67 Project Information

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing to resurface approximately 3.75 miles of WIS 67 in Walworth County. The purpose of this project is to provide long-term improvements to the pavement, operation, and safety of the roadway.

Project Goals:



Resurface the roadway from South Main Street to Theatre Road



Upgrade and replace pedestrian curb ramps



Repair three box culverts



Construct a shared-use path from South Main Street to Dewey Avenue to provide continuous bike and pedestrian accommodations

- Alternative 1 – along the northwest side of WIS 67, would include right-of-way from Fontana Fen Park to St. Benedict Catholic Church.
- Alternative 2 – along the southeast side of WIS 67, may require retaining walls due to steep existing slopes. The path would involve crossing WIS 67 twice, at South Main Street and at Dewey Avenue.

Timeline:

- Local Officials Meeting – May 2024
- Public Involvement Meeting #1 – June 2024
- Preliminary Design – Late 2024
- Public Involvement Meeting #2 – Summer 2025
- Real Estate Acquisition – Summer 2025
- Final Design – Summer 2026
- Construction – Spring 2027 (subject to funding availability)

Traffic and Real Estate:

Access to local residences and businesses will be maintained throughout the project.

Traffic control for the project is still being evaluated.

Minor real estate acquisition is anticipated due to pedestrian curb ramp upgrades and proposed shared-use path.
