WIS 67 Resurfacing – South Main Street to Theatre Road

ID: 3325-08-00/70

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is proposing to resurface approximately 3.75 miles of WIS 67 in Walworth County. The purpose of this project is to provide long-term improvements to the pavement, operation, and safety of the roadway.

Proposed Improvements:

- Resurface the roadway from South Main Street to Theatre Road
- Replace pedestrian curb ramps
- · Repair three box culverts
- Construct a shared-use path from South Main Street to Dewey Avenue to provide continuous bike and pedestrian accommodations
 - Alternative 1 along the northwest side of WIS 67, would include right-of-way from Fontana Fen Park to St. Benedict Catholic Church.
 - Alternative 2 along the southeast side of WIS 67, may require retaining walls due to steep existing slopes. The path would involve crossing WIS 67 twice, at South Main Street and at Dewey Avenue.

Traffic Impacts:

Construction is anticipated to **start in 2027,** subject to funding. Access to local residences and businesses will be maintained. Traffic control for the project is still being evaluated.
