- **Refinement of pedestrian and bicycle facilities and access management along the corridor**

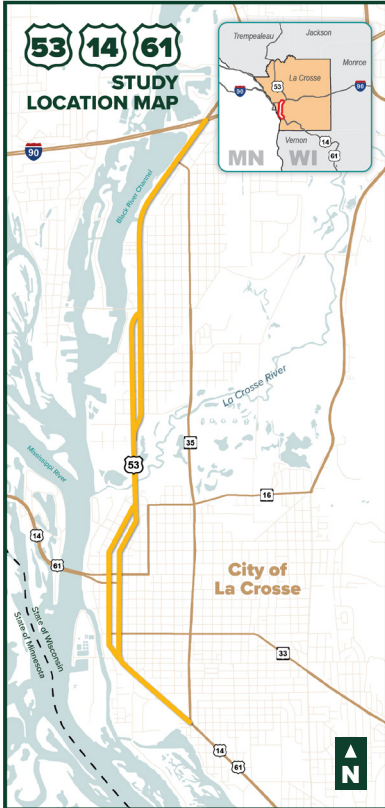
