Project Purpose and Need

To preserve the roadway and structure assets, including addressing ride quality and roadway deficiencies for 3.6 miles of US 12 between Terrace Avenue and Gammon Avenue.

Structural deficiencies



US 12/14 Westbound over Greenway Blvd (B-13-230) – spalling between girders and deteriorating bridge deck

Roadway deficiencies



Deteriorating pavement; cracking and rutting, beam guard deficiencies, deteriorating guardrail, and substandard curb ramps

Proposed Improvements

Roadway

- Pavement resurfacing – Mill and overlay
- Concrete Patching on ramps and sideroads
- Replace/upgrade beam guard in select locations
- Signal upgrades
- Curb ramp reconstruction



Proposed Improvements

Roadway

- Signal upgrades at Gammon Road, Mineral Point Road and Old Sauk Road interchanges.
- Replace all above ground equipment to meet current standards.
- Partial replacement of below ground traffic signal equipment.



Proposed Improvements



Structural

- Deck repair and overlay of the westbound bridge over Greenway Blvd

Project Impacts

- Traffic Impacts
 - Temporary lane closures on US 12 at night - between 9pm to 6am
 - Temporary lane closures on Greenway Blvd WB at night – between 9pm to 6am
 - Temporary on/off ramp closures on US 12 - between 9pm to 6am
 - One ramp at a time
 - Lane closures on local streets between 9pm and 6am
 - Pedestrian accommodations on local streets will be provided with temporary curb ramps
- No environmental impacts anticipated
- Temporary limited easements (TLE) and permanent acquisition (FEE) are not anticipated

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

US 12 (Terrace Avenue to Gammon Road), Madison - Dane County

Project overview

The purpose of this project is to maintain connectivity along US 12 by addressing the existing roadway pavement conditions. WisDOT is proposing to resurface 3.4 miles of US 12 between Terrace Avenue and Gammon Road.

Additional improvements include:

- Replacement/upgraded beam guard
- Signal updates
 - Gammon Road interchange
 - Mineral Point Road interchange
 - Old Sauk Road interchange
- Curb ramp replacement
- Deck repair and overlay of westbound bridge over Greenway Boulevard

Schedule

- April 2025 - Public Involvement
- Summer 2029 - Construction anticipated

Traffic impacts/detours

Work is anticipated to take place under lane closures and ramp closures will be expected during evening work hours.

- Public Involvement Meeting: May 28, 2025
- Comments period ends: June 13, 2025
 - Date to submit comments to be included in the environmental record. Comments are welcome throughout the project.
- Environmental Document: August 2025
- Final Plans: Fall 2027
- Construction is currently scheduled to begin in 2029 but could occur as early as 2028.
