




Project location

US 12/18 intersection with County W and Oak Park Road







Project needs

Intersection safety and traffic operations

- 10 of 16 reported crashes from 2015 to 2019 were injury crashes
- Side road traffic experiences delay and queuing, which can lead to higher risk decision-making






Project needs

Intersection safety and traffic operations

- <u>Trends:</u> rear-end crashes on US 12/18 with left-turning vehicles; right angle crashes
- <u>Contributing factors</u>: high speed, failure to stop for leftturning vehicles, failure to yield on side streets









• Alternatives reviewed and presented at public meeting in January 2022

Improved two-way stop control











Previous studies and public involvement Late 2021/early 2022

- Meeting attendees agreed safety and operations are a concern and improvements are needed.
- Improved Two-way Stop Control does not reduce potential crash severity or improve operations for side roads.
- Traffic Signal requires most extensive reconstruction with highest cost, and still has potential for high severity crashes.
- Roundabout expected to have less severe crashes and better traffic operations at a lower cost than a traffic signal. (Recommended Alternative)



Proposed improvements Single lane roundabout


- New concrete and asphalt pavement
- New storm sewer and culverts
- New signs and pavement marking
- Intersection lighting






Proposed improvements Right of way needs

- Strip right of way and temporary grading easements for intersection improvements
- See exhibit on project website for additional information
- Acquisition process expected to begin in spring 2024




Anticipated construction impacts Staged construction in 2026


- US 12/18 to remain open during construction
- Oak Park Road and County W expected to be closed during some stages
 - No posted detour for Oak Park Road
 - Detour options for County W are being discussed with Dane County
- Access to local residents and businesses will be maintained throughout construction



Anticipated construction impacts Staged construction in 2026




Anticipated construction impacts Staged construction in 2026



Project schedule

- Environmental document was completed June 2022
- Real estate acquisition to begin spring 2024
- Project plans to be completed August 2025
- Construction in summer 2026
 - Utility work anticipated prior to construction
