PROJECT INFORMATION

WisDOT is proposing to improve approximately 6.54 miles of USH 14 from the Wisconsin River to Oak Street in the Village of Arena, which was last resurfaced in 2004. See the attached project location map. The existing pavement exhibits signs of fatigue in the form of rutting, longitudinal, and transverse cracking.

Proposed improvements include:

- 1) Extending the service life of the asphaltic pavement
 - a) Mill approximately 2.5" of the existing asphaltic surface
 - b) Overlay with 2.5" of HMA pavement
- 2) Centerline and shoulder rumble strips
- 3) New pavement markings

PROPOSED TRAFFIC IMPACTS

Construction is currently scheduled to begin in the summer of 2022 and is expected to be completed within 6-8 weeks.

USH 14 will remain open to thru traffic during construction through the use of flagging operations. Temporary driveway closures may be necessary during parts of the construction process. Construction staff will contact homeowners and businesses in advance before closing a driveway. If you have special access needs during construction please let us know so these can be considered as much as possible, and if needed included in the bidding documents.




PROJECT LOCATION
