Project Location

- US 151 & County C Intersection
- Between City of Beaver Dam & City of Waupun
- Town of Trenton, Dodge County







Safety Analysis

- Right Angle Crash Causes
 - Left turn movement
 - Thru traffic movement from County C
- Inadequate median width for semi-trucks
- High number of conflict points for high speed highway





Project Goals

- Reduce right angle crashes
 - Reduce conflict points
 - Simplify driver decision-making
- Eliminate semi-trucks blocking travel lanes while stopped in the median
- Accommodate agricultural equipment & semi-trucks






Restricted Crossing U-Turn (RCUT) Proposed Design








Semi-Truck / Agricultural Thru Movement








Passenger Car Thru Movement

Passenger Car Left Turn




















Left Turn (US 151 to County C)

Safety Improvement Research

- Federal Highway Administration RCUT Study (2013)
 - Injury/Fatality Rate decreased by 54%
- WisDOT RCUT Study (2019)
 - Injury/Fatality Rate decreased by 90.13%





Agricultural Equipment & Snowmobiles

- Agricultural Equipment
 - 12 feet wide turn lanes & 6 feet wide paved shoulders (18 feet total paved width)
 - Right Turn Lanes
 - U-Turn Lanes
- Snowmobiles
 - WisDOT will coordinate with the Snowmobile Club and Dodge County to locate the crossing through the new RCUT intersection





Real Estate

- Minimal Real Estate will be needed in Northeast and Southwest Quadrants
- WisDOT Real Estate Agent will be reaching out to property owners this fall



Project Schedule

- Public Involvement Meeting #1: September 21, 2022
- Public Involvement Meeting #2: September 19, 2023
- Preliminary Design Plans: Fall 2023
- Final Design Plans Approved: Fall 2024
- Project Construction: Summer 2025
