Purpose of the meeting

The purpose of this meeting is to gather public input and answer any questions about the proposed project on WIS 113 from the Lodi City Limits to WIS 60 in Columbia County.

The purpose of this project is to improve the safety and service life of this section of WIS 113. The need for this project is pavement deterioration, curb ramps not up to Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, and curb and gutter deterioration.

Project information

WisDOT is proposing to improve 0.57 miles of WIS 113. Proposed improvements include:

- Pavement Improvements
 - Lodi City Limits (Bellin Street) to County K
 - 4.5-inch mill and asphaltic pavement overlay
 - o County K to the bridge over Spring Creek Full Pavement Structure Replacement
 - Remove existing pavement and pavement structure
 - 5.5-inch of new asphaltic pavement
 - 28-inch of new gravel under asphaltic pavement
 - Bridge over Spring Creek to WIS 60
 - 9-inch concrete repair and replacement
- Curb Ramps
 - Replace 13 existing ramps to meet current ADA standards
 - Add 1 new ramps at the southeast quadrant of Bellin St intersection
- Add curb and gutter on the eastside of WIS 113 between Sodders Street and the bridge over Spring Creek
- Remove 3 driveways along WIS 113
 - 2 driveways for Bushnell Ford Dealership on WIS 113
 - 1 driveway for Lucky Duck Resale Thrift Store on WIS 113
- No work would be planned for the bridge over Spring Creek

Proposed traffic impacts

Construction is scheduled to begin spring/summer 2030.

During construction, WIS 113 is planned to be closed to thru traffic for the entire duration of construction. During the closure, a detour is planned to be in place using WIS 60, I-39/90/94, and WIS 19. Motorists can expect to encounter lane closures and flagging operations while the road is being removed and repaved.

During curb ramp construction, portions of the sidewalk around the curb ramps are planned to be closed. The curb ramps are planned to be constructed in stages and a pedestrian detour in place to allow for access around each intersection.

WisDOT recognizes businesses located in work zones have special needs. It's critical that customers have access to businesses and that they continue to visit them, regardless of any road work inconvenience and detour route. Temporary driveway closures will be necessary during parts of the construction process. WisDOT will contact homeowners and businesses in advance before closing a driveway. If a driveway is closed, the driveway would likely be open within a few hours of closing.

Construction is currently scheduled for completion summer/fall 2030.




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PROJECT LOCATION MAP WIS 113


CITY OF LODI SOUTHERN LIMITS TO WIS 60 INTERSECTION COLUMBIA COUNTY






DETOUR MAP WIS 113
