






Project Location

- WIS 113
 - WIS 78 to Mount St





















Purpose and Need

- Purpose
 - Replace the pavement of WIS 113
- Need
 - The existing pavement has extensive alligator cracking, edge cracking, longitudinal and transverse cracking.


















Proposed Improvements

- Pavement
 - Mill and remove 4" of existing asphalt pavement
 - Mill or pulverize 5" of remaining asphalt pavement/underlying base
 - Place 4" of new asphalt pavement

















Proposed Improvements

- Curve Reconstruction
 - Approximately 0.5 miles south of County DL (west)/Tower Rd
 - Safety analysis concluded to reconstruct curve
 - Larger radius
 - Highway moves about 18' southwest



















Proposed Improvements

- Other Improvements
 - Replace all segments of beam guard
 - Extend curb and gutter from Mound St to Effinger Rd





















Traffic Impacts

- Detour
 - Full road closure at horizontal curve reconstruction
 - Local access maintained
 - Detour route via WIS 78 and US 12
- Traffic Control
 - Lane closures and flaggers throughout during pavement replacement




















Real Estate

- Horizontal Curve
 - Acquiring right-of-way to accommodate new alignment
 - 0.106 acres from two WDNR parcels
- No other impacts anticipated


