Dear project stakeholder:

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is seeking your input on a proposed resurfacing project on WIS 28 between Ellsworth Street in Horicon to the North Junction County TW in the Town of Williamstown in Dodge County. The purpose of the proposed work is to address the pavement, which is showing signs of deterioration.

A public involvement comment period is scheduled for the period from October 15 to October 30, 2020. Based on current health information from state, federal and local health departments, WisDOT is selecting this format in lieu of a face to face public meeting in order to gather public feedback in a safe manner. The proposed improvements include milling the existing asphalt pavement and overlaying it with new asphalt. Other improvements include replacing the existing guardrail just southwest of the WIS 28/Schwarze Road intersection, new rumble strips, and new pavement marking. Prior to this construction project, Dodge County is being provided a Local Force Account (LFA) to conduct in-kind replacement of several culvert pipes one year prior to this project to ensure natural settlement has taken place preventing subsidence of the roadway after the mill and overlay.

Through your participation in the public comment period, we hope to obtain your input on the identified needs, proposed improvements, and proposed detour route along this segment of WIS 28. An improvement project is currently scheduled for 2025 however it could get advanced to as early as 2023 if funding becomes available.
