


EXISTING CONDITIONS

The project is located on WIS 35 beginning approximately 250 feet north of County E in Lynxville and ending approximately 550 feet north of Old Hwy 35 south of De Soto. WIS 35 was last reconditioned in 2010. The pavement is in poor condition with severe cracking and rutting. Additionally, the existing guardrail end terminals and railing type do not meet current standards. Many of the curb ramps located the village of Ferryville do not meet current standards. Some culverts located throughout the project are showing signs of deterioration in the form of rust and erosion. Also, some structures have deteriorated and need repair.

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

The proposed work consists of a pavement resurface. The project will remove 3 inches of existing asphalt and then pave 3.5 inches of new hot mix asphalt (HMA) pavement. The project will also replace guardrail, replace three culvert pipes, replace and add curb ramps, and replace some concrete curb and gutter. Additionally, the project will extend one box culvert and repair one bridge.

REAL ESTATE

A small amount of additional right of way will be required for this project to construct curb ramps and sidewalk in urban locations. Right of way will also be required to grade proper slopes on the west side of WIS 35. WisDOT anticipates beginning real estate acquisition as early as the winter of 2022-2023.

DEVELOP FINAL PLANS

It is anticipated that final plans will be completed in 2024. The bid letting is anticipated for November 2025 with construction currently scheduled for 2026. However, project may be advanced for construction to occur in 2025.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC IMPACTS

WIS 35 will remain open during construction. Temporary daytime single lane closures and shoulder closures will be necessary utilizing flagging operations during construction. Temporary traffic signals will be installed to complete work in several isolated locations. Access to adjacent properties will be maintained during construction.
