The objective of today's meeting is to obtain your input on the identified needs and proposed improvements. The meeting will follow an open house format.


Project information

WisDOT is proposing to improve 7.88 miles of WIS 78 between US 14 and US 12. Proposed improvements include:

- Mill and overlay asphaltic pavement
- Upgrade of guardrail end treatments
- Installation of centerline and shoulder rumble strips as a safety design treatment

These improvements will address the deteriorating pavement. If not repaired, the pavement life will be significantly reduced leading to the need for premature reconstruction of the pavement.

Proposed traffic impacts

During construction, WIS 78 is expected to remain open to traffic. Flagging operations and shoulder closures will be used to manage traffic during the project. Construction is currently scheduled for 2022.
