




Project Location

This box culvert is located 1,300 feet west of Primmer Lane.

Steep Embankments

This box culvert is located 25 feet west of Nemec Hill Road.




Box Culvert C-62-321-Interior

 Widen roadway width to meet current rural roadway design standards

Upgrade guardrail to current design standards








Preferred Alternative

This box culvert is located 1,300 feet west of Primmer Lane.






















Preferred Alternative

This box culvert is located 25 feet west of Nemec Hill Road.






















Preferred Alternative

Real Estate Impacts

 Real estate impacts are anticipated at each of the three box culvert locations

 WisDOT will be coordinating with property owners individually for any permanent or temporary real estate needs







What will happen to WS 82 traffic?

From the WIS 56/82 Intersection to La Farge

- WIS 82 is proposed to be individually closed at each structure replacement
- A detour will be implemented
- Construction will be staged in a manner that will allow access to property at all times








What will happen to WS 82 traffic?

Estimated detour duration is 3 months





- Box Culvert replacements (x3)
- · Replace roadway approaches to box culverts
