

### **Project Limits**

#### 13.1 Miles from East Ave in Belleville to US 14, east of Brooklyn



















### **Project Purpose and Need**

- Purpose
  - Maintain safe and efficient travel on WIS 92.
  - Ensure roadway continues to serve as a local and regional link in the transportation system.
- Need
  - Address pavement deterioration/deficiencies.
  - Bring outdated Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) curb ramps to current standards.













### **Major Features**

- 2-inch HMA pavement mill and overlay
- Centerline rumble strips in rural portion
- Update curb ramps to meet ADA requirements
- Repair guardrail where needed
- Removing HMA kickouts at gravel driveways and field entrances








### **Typical Sections Belleville Urban Typical Section**

East Ave – Vondra Dr.

















# Typical Sections Belleville – Brooklyn Rural Typical Section

- 2-inch HMA pavement mill and overlay
- New centerline rumble strips
- New lanes will be painted 12-feet wide (current width is 11-feet)



Vondra Dr. – Union Rd.


















### **Typical Sections Brooklyn Urban Typical Section**

- Existing curb and gutter will remain



















# Typical Sections Brooklyn – US 14 Rural Typical Section












### **Curb Ramp Updates** 4<sup>th</sup> Street

- Add west crosswalk






















### **Curb Ramp Updates Commercial/Market Street**

- Slightly reconfigure crosswalks


















### **Curb Ramp Updates Hotel Street**

- Existing colored crosswalks to remain in-place













- Reconfigure crosswalks




















#### **Traffic Control**

- Some minor delays, but no detours




















### **Special Considerations**


