LEGEND

AIRPORTS Facilities meeting at least FAA Class I minimum design standards as to its landing strip length and width, obstructions, etc.

AIR FIELDS Facilities having less than landing strips, one of which is at least 1000' long.

AIR STRIPS Facilities having only one landing strip which is at least 800' long.

LANDING AREAS Facilities having one or more landing strips, one of which are under 800' long.

SEAPLANE BASES General purpose facilities having a ramp, dock, and all facilities, repairs, etc.

SEAPLANE BASES (LIMITED) Small seaplane facilities having a dock or ramp, and gas and oil services only.

NOTE: Landing facilities listed have gas, oil and a daytime broadcast.
