



AIR NAVIGATION AIDS

108.10-111.95 MHz: ILS localizer with or without simultaneous radio-telephone channel operating on odd-tenth decimal frequencies (108.1, 108.3, etc.)

108.0-117.95 VOR's

COMMUNICATIONS

121.5 MHz: Emergency (World-Wide), ELT Signal Civil communications frequencies used in the FSS air/ground system are now operated simplex on 122.0, 122.2, 122.3, 122.4, 122.6, 122.7, 123.6; emergency 121.5; plus receive-only on 122.05, 122.1, 122.15, and 123.6.

- a. 122.0 is assigned to selected FSS's as the Enroute Flight Advisory Service channel.
- b. 122.2 is assigned to all FSS's as a common enroute simplex service.
- c. 123.6 is assigned as the airport advisory channel at non-tower FSS locations; however, it is still in commission at some FSS's collocated with towers to provide part-time Airport Advisory Service.
- d. 122.1 is the primary receive-only frequency at VORs. 122.05, 122.15 and 123.6 are assigned at selected VORs meeting certain criteria.

TRAFFIC ADVISORY PRACTICES WHERE A TOWER IS NOT IN OPERATION

There is no substitute for alertness while in the vicinity of an airport. An airport may have a flight service station, UNICOM operator, or no facility at all. Pilots should predetermine what, if any, service is available at a particular airport. Combining an aural/visual alertness and complying with the following recommended practices will enhance safety of flight into and out of uncontrolled airports.

1. Recommend Traffic Advisory Practices—As standard operating practice, all inbound traffic should continuously monitor the appropriate field facility frequency from 15 miles to landing. Departure aircraft should monitor the appropriate frequency either prior to or when ready to taxi. See appropriate Airport Facility/Directory or Aeronautical Charts.

^{*} If tower temporarily closed use tower local control frequency for traffic advisory practices unless frequency is specified in applicable NOTAM. If broadcast of position or intentions in the blind (self announce) is used and a UNICOM is in operation at the airport, it is suggested the wind direction and runway in use be obtained from UNICOM even though tower frequency is used for self announce procedures.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES GENERAL

- 1. A pilot in any emergency phase (uncertainty, alert, or distress) should do three things to obtain assistance:
 - a. If equipped with a coded radar beacon transponder (civil) or IFF/SIF (military), and if unable to establish voice communications with an air traffic control facility, switch to Mode 3/A and Code 7700. Military transponder should also be placed in the emergency position. If crash is imminent and equipped with a Locator Beacon, actuate the emergency signal.
 - b. Contact controlling agency and give nature of distress and pilot's intentions. If unable to contact controlling agencies, attempt to contact any agency on assigned frequency 121.5 MHz (transmit and receive).

Transmit as much of the following as possible:

- (1) MAYDAY, MAYDAY, MAYDAY (if distress), or PAN, PAN, PAN (if uncertainty or alert). If CW transmission, use SOS (distress) or XXX (uncertainty or alert).
- (2) Aircraft identification repeated three times.
- (3) Type of aircraft.
- (4) Position or estimated position (stating which).
- (5) Heading (true or magnetic) (stating which).
- (6) True airspeed or estimated true airspeed (stating which).
- (7) Altitude.
- (8) Fuel remaining in hours and minutes.
- (9) Nature of distress.
- (10) Pilot's intentions (bailout, ditch, crash landing, etc.).
- (11) Assistance desired (fix, steer, bearing, escort, etc.).
- (12) Two 10-second dashes with mike button (voice) or key (CW) followed by aircraft identification (once) and OVER (voice) or K (CW).

NOTE-ARTCC emergency frequency capability normally does not extend to radar coverage limits. If the ARTCC does not respond to transmission on emergency frequency 121.5 MHz or 243.0 MHZ, pilots should initiate a call to the nearest Flight Service Station or Airport Traffic Control Tower.

c. Comply with information and clearance received. Accept the communications control offered to you by the ground radio station, silence interfering radio stations, and do not shift frequency or shift to another ground station unless absolutely necessary.

- 2. Pilots of IFR flights experiencing two-way radio failure are expected to adhere to the procedures prescribed under "RADIO COMMUNICATIONS FAILURE" (FAR Part 91.127).
 - a. The Pilot should remember that he has two means of declaring an emergency:
 - (1) Emergency SQUAWK from transponders (CODE 7700)
 - (2) Sending emergency message
 - b. Some ground stations have three electronic means of assisting:
 - (1) Receipt of emergency message
 - (2) DF bearings; and
 - (3) Detection of transponder emergency SQUAWK. (CODE 7700)
 - c. Pilots should remember the FOUR C's
 - (1) Confess your predicament to any ground radio station. Do not wait too long. Give SAR a chance!
 - (2) Communicate with your ground link and pass as much of the distress message on first transmission as possible. We need information for best SAR action!
 - (3) Climb if possible for better radar and DF detection. If flying at low altitude, the chance for establishing radio contact is improved by climbing, also chances of alerting radar systems are sometimes improved by climbing or descending.

NOTE--Unauthorized climb or descent under IFR conditions within controlled airspace is not permitted except in emergency. Any variation in altitude, in connection with flying radar patterns will be unknown to Air Traffic Control except at radar locations having height finding capabilities. Air Traffic Control will operate on the assumption that the provisions of FAR 91.127 are being followed by the pilot.

- (4) Comply, especially Comply, with advice and instructions received, if you really want help. Assist the ground "communications control" station to control communications on the distress frequency on which you are working (as that is the distress frequency for your case). Tell interfering stations to maintain silence until you call. Cooperate!
- 3. For bailout, set radio for continuous emission. For ditching or crash landing, radio should, if it is considered that there is no additional risk of fire and if circumstances permit, be set for continuous transmission.
- 4. When a pilot is in doubt of his position, or feels apprehensive for his safety, he should not hesitate to request assistance. Search and Rescue facilities, including Radar, Radio and DF stations, are ready and willing to help. There is no penalty for using them. Delay has caused accidents and cost lives. Safety is not a luxury. Take Action!

RULES PERTAINING TO AIRCRAFT ACCIDENTS, INCIDENTS, OVERDUE AIRCRAFT, AND SAFETY INVESTIGATIONS

(National Transportation Safety Board, Procedural Regulation, 49 CFR 830 (in part)).

1. IMMEDIATE NOTIFICATION

The operator of an aircraft shall immediately, and by the most expeditious means available, notify the nearest National Transportation Safety Board, Bureau of Aviation Safety Field Office when:

- a. An aircraft accident or any of the following listed incidents occur:
 - 1. Flight control system malfunction or failure;
 - 2. Inability of any required flight crew member to perform his normal flight duties as a result of injury or illness;
 - 3. Turbine engine rotor failures excluding compressor blades and turbine buckets;
 - 4. In-flight fire;
 - 5. Aircraft collide in flight.

- b. An aircraft is overdue and is believed to have been involved in an accident.
- c. The following information is required if available:
 - 1. Type, nationality, and registration marks of the aircraft;
 - 2. Name of the pilot-in-command;
 - 3. Date and time of the accident;
 - 4. Last point of departure and point of intended landing of the aircraft;
 - 5. Position of the aircraft with reference to some easily defined geographical point;
 - 6. Number of persons aboard, number killed, and number seriously injured;
 - 7. Nature of the accident, the weather, and the extent of damage to the aircraft, so far as is known; and
 - 8. A description of any explosives, radioactive materials, or other dangerous articles carried.

2. MANNER OF NOTIFICATION

The most expeditious method of notification to the National Transportation Safety Board by the operator will be determined by the circumstances existing at that time. The National Transportation Safety Board has advised that any of the following would be considered examples of the type of notification that would be acceptable:

- a. Direct telephone notification.
- b. Telegraphic notification.
- c. Notification to the Federal Aviation Administration who would in turn notify the NTSB by direct communication; i.e., dispatch or telephone.

3. REPORTS

- a. The operator shall file a report on NTSB form 6120.1 or 6120.2 available from the National Transportation Safety Board Field Offices, or the National Transportation Safety Board, Washington, D.C. 20591
 - 1. Within ten (10) days after an occurrence for which notification is required in 1 (a) and (b) above;
 - 2. When, after seven (7) days, an overdue aircraft is still missing.
 - 3. Upon request of an authorized representative of the National Transportation Safety Board:

b. Each crew member, if physically able at the time the report is submitted, shall attach thereto a statement setting forth the facts, conditions and circumstances relating to the accident or occurrence as they appear to him to the best of his knowledge and belief. If the crew member is incapacitated, he shall submit the statement as soon as he is physically able.

4. WHERE TO FILE THE REPORTS

- a. The operator of an aircraft shall file with the Field Office of the National Transportation Safety Board nearest the accident or incident any report required by this section.
- b. The National Transportation Safety Board field offices are listed under U.S. Government in the telephone directories in the following cities: Anchorage, Alaska; Chicago, Ill.; Denver, Colo.; Fort Worth, Texas; Kansas City, Mo.; Los Angeles, Calif.; Miami, Fla.; New York, N.Y.; Seattle, Wash.; Washington, D.C.



VISUAL APPROACH SLOPE INDICATOR (VASI)

When on the proper glide path, the pilot will overshoot the downwind bars and undershoot the upwind bars. Thus he will see the downwind bars as white and the upwind bars as red. From a position below the glide path, the pilot will see the light bars as red and from above the glide path, the light bars will appear white. Passing through the path from a low position is indicated to the pilot by a transition in color from red through pink to white. From a high position, passing through the path is indicated to the pilot by a transition in color from white through pink to red. When the pilot is below the glide path, the red bars tend to merge into one distinct red signal. A safe obstruction clearance may not exist when this distinct red signal is visible. The visual glide path will separate into individual lights as the pilot approaches the runway threshold. At this point, the should be continued by reference to the runway approach touchdown zone.
