SUBJECT 1	Introduction	

The design of new or improved traffic signal installations has many interrelated elements. Uniformity in the design of those elements promotes efficient traffic operations and reduces the potential for driver confusion and accidents. Traffic signals must be designed and installed to convey clear and positive guidance to drivers and pedestrians. This section contains discussions, illustrations, and examples of the following design elements that are necessary to achieve this.
