ADDENDUM NO. 01 4430-16-60 August 6, 2015

Special Provisions

3. Prosecution and Progress.

Replace the fourth paragraph with the following:

The anticipated start of work on B-15-4 is May 1, 2016. STH 42/57 between Green Bay Road and Egg Harbor Road shall be closed to vehicular and pedestrian traffic concurrently with the beginning of construction of Project 4140-20-73 (see "Other Contracts") or May 1, 2016, whichever occurs first. Structure B-15-4 shall remain open to waterway users until May 1, 2016. STH 42/57 and Structure B-15-4 shall open to all traffic prior to 12:01 AM June 24, 2016.

Detour traffic as described in the "Traffic" article of these special provisions. Lane closures along STH 42/57 will be permitted beginning October 17, 2015 as specified in the "Traffic" article for work associated with Structures B-15-5 and B-15-6. Coordinate traffic control and detour work with the contractor of WisDOT Project 4140-20-73 as described in these special provisions.

Replace entire section **B-15-4** with the following:

B-15-4

Replace select supporting steel beams, the steel grid deck with partial-depth concrete filled shoulder, the operating machinery, and incidental work as shown in the plans. The U.S. Coast Guard (USCG) will permit both bascule leaves to remain in the closed position to complete the work beginning May 1, 2016. The USCG may allow work to commence earlier than May 1, dependent on weather and other marine traffic conditions. Coordinate with the department and the USCG for any approvals necessary to close the bascule leaves prior to May 1, 2016. Work will be permitted on segments of Structure B-15-4 that do not affect waterway navigation prior to May 1, 2016.

Install buoys and comply with the state and federal requirements as described in articles "Buoys Waterway" and "Construction Over or Adjacent to Navigable Waters", respectively.

Complete construction operations on STH 42/57 to the stage necessary to reopen it to through traffic prior to 12:01 AM, June 24, 2016. Do not reopen until completing the work noted above under section B-15-4.

Supplement standard spec 108.11 as follows:

If the contractor fails to complete the work necessary to reopen STH 42/57 to through traffic prior to 12:01 AM, June 24, 2016, the department will assess the contractor \$15,000 in interim liquidated damages for each calendar day that the roadway remains closed after 12:01 AM, June 24, 2016. An entire calendar day will be charged for each day that the road remains closed beyond 12:01 AM.

If contract time expires prior to completing all work specified in the contract, additional liquidated damages will be affixed according to standard spec 108.11.

4. Traffic.

Replace entire section **Trucks** with the following:

Trucks

Northbound traffic will be detoured via S. Madison Avenue, Michigan Street, N. 14th Avenue, Egg Harbor Road, and Old Hwy Road (Egg Harbor Connector).

Southbound traffic will be detoured via Old Hwy Road (Egg Harbor Connector), Egg Harbor Road, N. 14th Avenue, Michigan Street, and S. Madison Avenue.

Replace entire section Non-truck with the following:

Non-truck

Northbound traffic will be detoured via S. Madison Avenue, Michigan Street, N. 3rd Avenue, Jefferson Street, Egg Harbor Road, and Old Hwy Road (Egg Harbor Connector).

Southbound traffic will be detoured via Old Hwy Road (Egg Harbor Connector), Egg Harbor Road, Jefferson Street, N. 3rd Avenue, Michigan Street, and S. Madison Avenue.

8. Other Contracts.

Replace entire article language with the following:

The department will be reconstructing STH 42/57 from south of Michigan Street to north of Egg Harbor Road under Project 4140-20-73. This project is anticipated to begin in April 2016, and its schedule will overlap with the schedule for Project 4430-16-60. The project consists of reconstructing the roadway and intersections at Michigan Street, Alabama Street, and Egg Harbor Road. This section of STH 42/57 will be closed during construction.

Project 4430-16-60 will share and be responsible for the same detour route as Project 4140-20-73; however, construction for Project 4140-20-73 will begin prior to mobilization for Project 4430-16-60. Coordinate the detour start date and signing with the department and the Project 4140-20-73 contractor.

The department will be completing a temporary connector for Project 4140-20-73 under Project 4140-20-74. The project is scheduled to take place in fall 2015 and will not impact traffic as no work is anticipated on roadways.

The engineer and Project 4140-20-73 contractor representative shall be invited to the weekly meeting for Project 4430-16-60. Contact Jeremy Ashauer, (920) 492-4165, at the Wisconsin Department of Transportation prior to bidding and during construction for updates.

9. Construction Over or Adjacent to Navigable Waters.

Replace the seventh paragraph with the following:

The USCG will permit both bascule leaves to be locked in the down position beginning May 1, 2016. The USCG may allow work to commence earlier than May 1. Coordinate with the department and the USCG for any approvals necessary to close the bascule leaves prior to May 1, 2016. Work will be permitted on segments of Structure B-15-4 that do not affect waterway navigation prior to May 1, 2016.

Remove section Placement of Navigational Aids during Construction.

46. Buoys Waterway, Item SPV.0045.01.

A Description

This work shall consist of furnishing, placing, maintaining, and removing waterway buoys, anchorages, flashing lights, and all other materials associated with this item, in accordance to the pertinent requirements of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) and as directed by the engineer. These requirements may be obtained on the internet at the following address: http://dnr.wi.gov/files/PDF/pubs/le/LE0317.pdf

B Materials

Buoys must be cylindrical in shape with a 7-inch minimum diameter and extend a minimum of 36 inches above the waterline. Danger buoys used while waterway navigation is allowed shall be white with an orange reflective diamond with the message "Bridge Work" and a flashing light adorning the buoy.

Navigational buoys shall be red and green as defined in the WDNR guidelines and shall be placed in pairs as shown in the plans.

Information buoys shall be placed approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ mile east and west of Structure B-15-4 and shall be white with an orange square. Information shall be printed in black with the message "Bridge Height Restricted – XX'-XX". Actual height restriction to be verified with engineer.

C Construction

Waterway buoys shall be placed in the water prior to any in-stream work (demolition or construction), and shall remain in place until such work is completed and all in-water obstructions, such as barges, are completely removed.

Coordinate with WDNR NE Region Safety Specialist Warden, Jeremy Cords, at (920) 366-1917, or email at Jeremy.Cords@Wisconsin.gov. Acceptance of the waterway buoys and their placement shall be at the discretion of the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources and the engineer.

D Measurement

The department will measure Buoys Waterway by the Day, acceptably completed, for the days which they are in the water, not to exceed the number of days for which the contractor is performing instream work.

E Payment

The department will pay for measured quantities at the contract unit price under the following bid item:ITEM NUMBERDESCRIPTIONSPV.0045.01Buoys WaterwayDAYS

Payment is full compensation for furnishing, placing, maintaining, and removing waterway buoys.


