#### **Special Provisions**

### 9. Information to Bidders, U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Section 404 Permit

Replace the last paragraph with the following:

As a requirement of the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers permitting process, a causeway can remain in place for up to 90 days from May 15<sup>th</sup> to November 15<sup>th</sup>. From November 16<sup>th</sup> to May 14<sup>th</sup> the causeway does not have a time limit when it can remain in place. The 90-day limit starts on May 15<sup>th</sup> or the date the causeway is installed between May 15<sup>th</sup> and November 15<sup>th</sup>. The causeway must be completely removed not only from the river, but also from the riverbank by the end of those 90 days.

The responsibility for notifying potential subcontractors and suppliers of these changes remains with the prime contractor.
