Special Provisions

6. Utilities.

Replace entire article language with the following:

This contract comes under the provisions of Wisconsin Administrative Code Chapter Trans 220. stp-107-065 (20080501)

There are underground and overhead utility facilities located within the project limits. Coordinate construction activities with a call to Diggers Hotline and/or a direct call to the utilities that have facilities in the area as required per statutes.

Use caution to ensure the integrity of underground utility facilities and maintain OSHA code clearances from overhead facilities at all times.

Project 1400-01-70:

Alliant Energy – Elec – has facilities within the project limits. Overhead facilities from approximate station 797+00 to approximate station 803+00 40 ft RT no conflicts anticipated with fill. Overhead line from approximate station 1157+26 to approximate station 1157+65 33 ft LT to 46 ft RT no conflicts anticipated.

Alliant Energy – Gas – has facilities within the project limits. Alliant has a gas line crossing Otsego Road at approximate station 802+76 approximately 13 feet deep. No conflicts are anticipated.

ATC – Electric/Transmission – has transmission lines throughout the entire project limits. No conflicts are anticipated with the 69 kV, 138 kV and 345 kV conductors.

Enbridge Energy – Gas/Petroleum has underground facilities crossing STH 16 at approximate station 682+50. No conflicts are anticipated.

Do not use the site for borrow or waste disposal. Do not use the site area not currently capped by asphalt/concrete for the staging of personnel, equipment and/or supplies.

<u>Cuff Cemetery (Site: 47CO172/BCo-0117)</u> site is located approximately from 3,500 feet and 4,825 feet south of the STH 16 intersection on the right side of CTH A within the limits shown on the plans.

Notify the Bureau of Technical Services – Environmental Process and Document Section (BTS-EPDS) at (608) 266-0099 at least two weeks before commencement of any ground disturbing activities beyond the existing right-of-way limits. BTS-EPDS will determine if a qualified archaeologist will need to be on site during construction of this area.

Do not use the site for borrow or waste disposal. Do not use the site area not currently capped by asphalt/concrete for the staging of personnel, equipment and/or supplies.
