Special Provisions

9. DELETED

32. Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources Safe Drinking Water Loan Fund for Water Main Construction.

Construction of City of Ashland water main and related items under this contract shall comply with the requirements of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) Safe Drinking Water Loan (SDWL) Program.

Comply with the following requirements:

- Davis-Bacon and Related Acts (DBRA) – If requested, in addition to electronic submittals of weekly payrolls through WisDOT’s Civil Rights Compliance System (CRCS), contractor shall provide information according to the WDNR SDWL guidelines linked below, to City of Ashland or their designated representative for contractors and subcontractors engaged in the installation of the water main items listed at the end of this section.

- Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs) – Contractor shall provide documentation of DBE compliance as described in the WDNR packet linked below:

- American Iron and Steel certification for materials related to the water main items listed at the end of this section:

The Contractor acknowledges to and for the benefit of the City of Ashland (“Purchaser”) and the State of Wisconsin (“State”) that it understands the goods and services under this Agreement are being funded with monies made available by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund and or Drinking Water State Revolving Fund that have statutory requirements commonly known as “American Iron and Steel”; that requires all of the iron and steel products used in the project to be produced in the United States (“American Iron and Steel Requirement”) including iron and steel products provided by the Contractor pursuant to this Agreement. The Contractor hereby represents and warrants to and for the benefit of the Purchaser and the State that (a) the Contractor has reviewed and understand the American Iron and Steel Requirement, (b) all of the iron and steel products used in the project will be and/or have been produced in the United States in a manner that complies with the American Iron and Steel Requirement, unless a waiver of the requirement is approved, and (c) the Contractor will provide any further verified information, certification or assurance of compliance with this paragraph, or information necessary to support a waiver of the American Iron and Steel Requirement, as may be requested by the Purchaser or the State. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Agreement, any failure to comply with this paragraph by the Contractor shall permit the Purchaser or State to recover as damages against the Contractor any loss, expense, or cost (including without limitation attorney’s fees) incurred by the Purchaser or State resulting from any such failure (including without limitation any impairment or loss of funding, whether in whole or in part, from the State or any damages owed to the State by the Purchaser). While the contractor has no direct contractual privity with the State, as a lender to the Purchaser for the funding of this project, the Purchaser and the Contractor agree that the State is a third-party beneficiary and neither this paragraph (nor any other provision of this Agreement to give this paragraph force or effect) shall be amended or waived without the prior written consent of the State.
