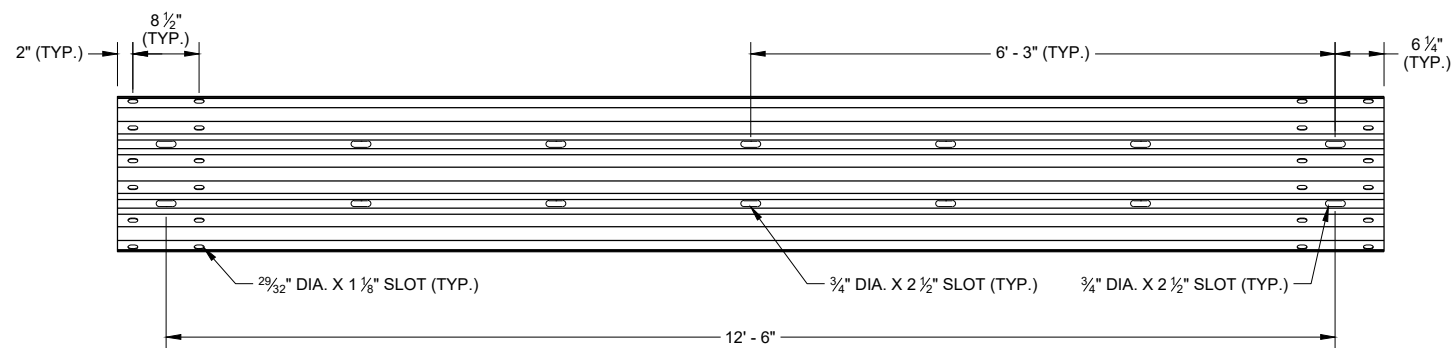
**ADDITIONAL THRIE BEAM

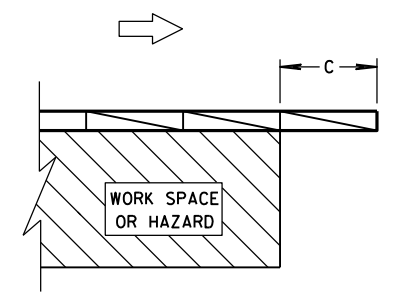

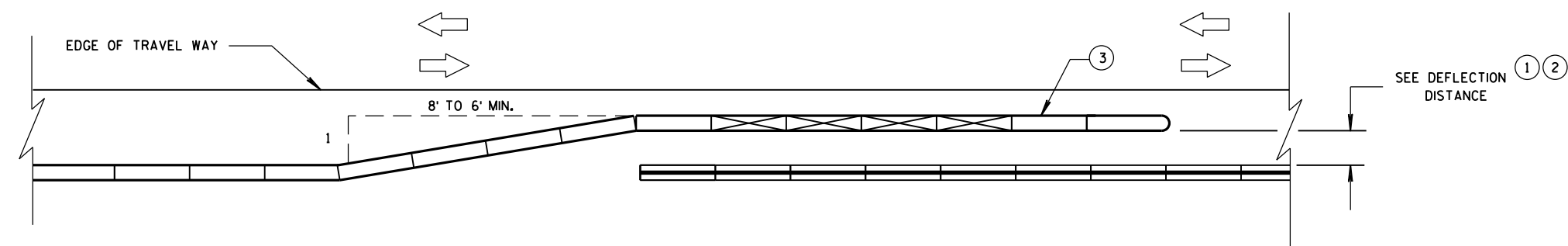

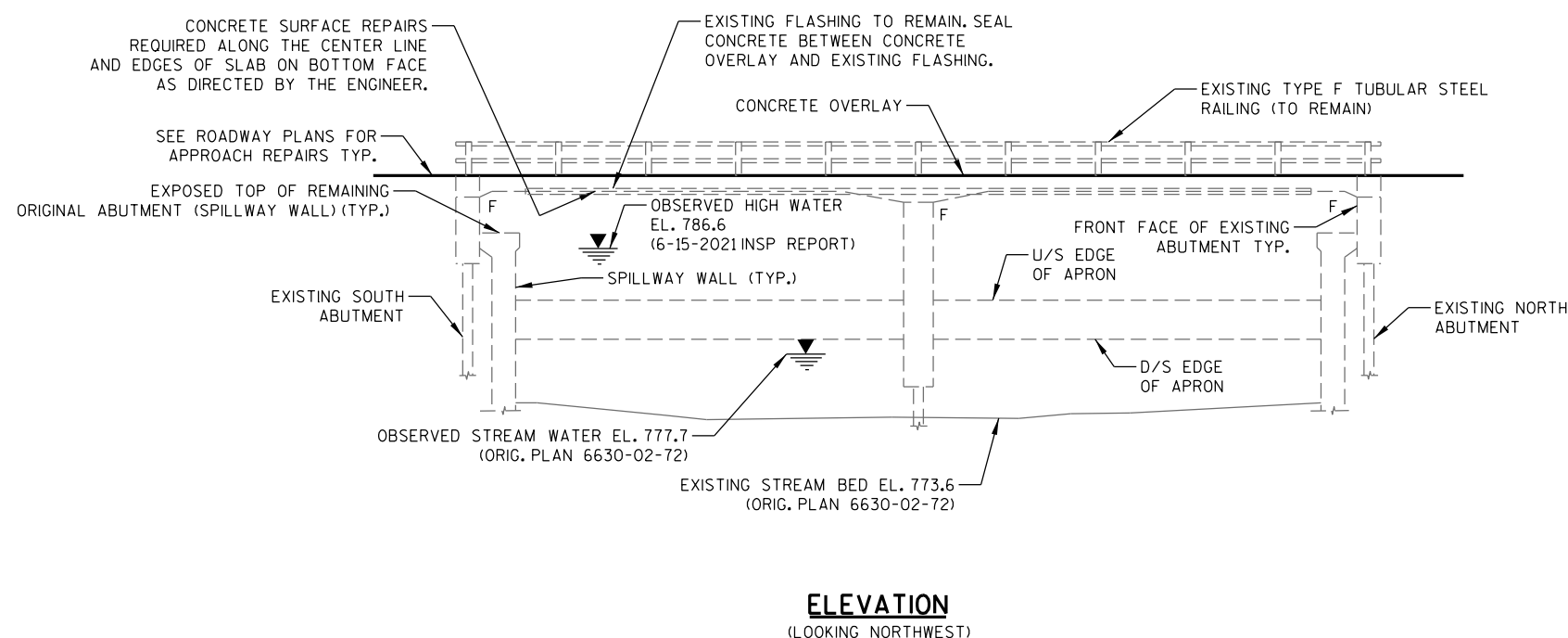

PROTECTIVE SURFACE TREATMENT SHALL BE APPLIED TO THE ENTIRE TOP SURFACE OF THE NEW CONCRETE OVERLAY AND CONCRETE SURFACE REPAIRS UNDER BID ITEM "PROTECTIVE SURFACE TREATMENT".

PROTECTIVE SURFACE TREATMENT RESEAL SHALL BE APPLIED TO THE AREAS LISTED BELOW UNDER BID ITEM "PROTECTIVE SURFACE TREATMENT RESEAL".

- EXPOSED CONCRETE ON TOP AND EXTERIOR FACE OF CONCRETE SLAB BETWEEN THE OVERLAY (CONCRETE) AND THE EXISTING FLASHING.
- EXPOSED TOP AND FRONT FACES OF SPILLWAY WALLS AND WINGWALLS.

THE EXISTING THIN POLYMER OVERLAY AND A MINIMUM OF 1" OF CONCRETE SHALL BE REMOVED FROM THE ENTIRE BRIDGE SLAB UNDER THE BID ITEM "CLEANING DECKS".

THE AVERAGE OVERLAY THICKNESS IS BASED ON THE MINIMUM OVERLAY THICKNESS PLUS 1/2-INCH TO ACCOUNT FOR VARIATIONS IN THE SLAB SURFACE.

PREPARATION DECKS TYPE 1, PREPARATION DECKS TYPE 2, AND FULL-DEPTH DECK REPAIR AREAS ARE BASED ON THE PLANS AND AS DETERMINED BY THE ENGINEER. DECK PREPARATION AND FULL-DEPTH DECK REPAIRS SHALL BE FILLED WITH "CONCRETE MASONRY OVERLAY DECKS".

ANY EXCAVATION REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE OVERLAY AT THE ABUTMENTS TO BE CONSIDERED INCIDENTAL TO THE BID ITEM "CONCRETE MASONRY OVERLAY DECKS".

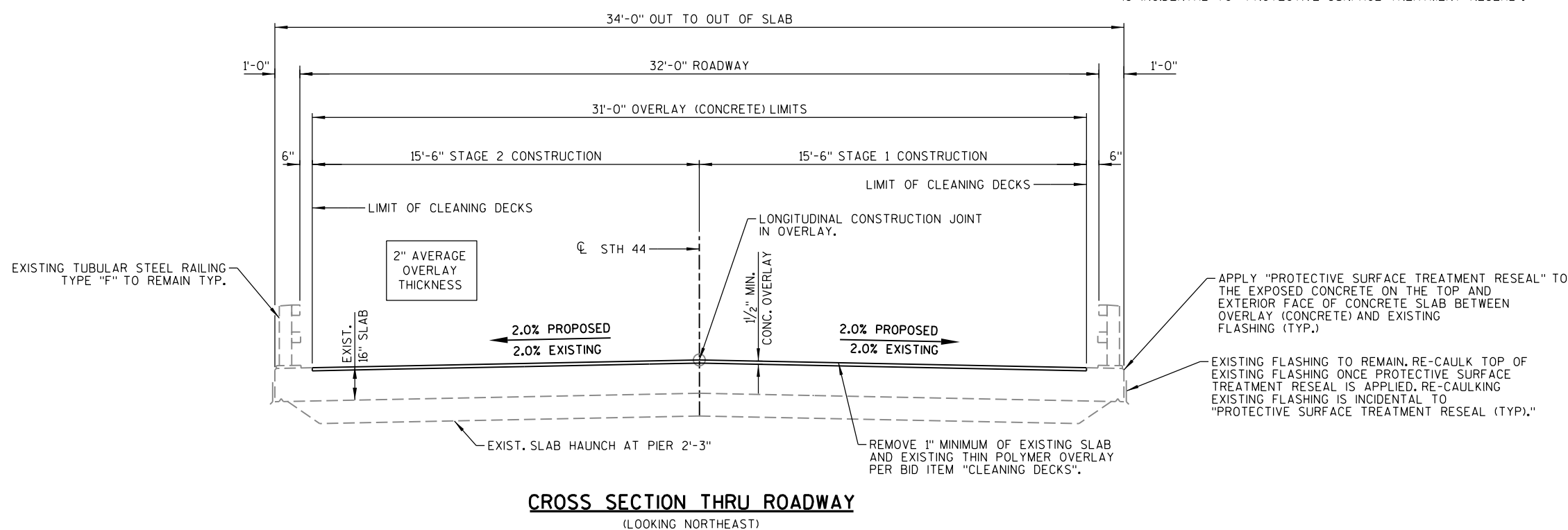
PROFILE GRADE LINE SHALL BE DETERMINED IN THE FIELD BASED ON MINIMUM OVERLAY THICKNESS OF 1 1/2" PLACED ABOVE THE SLAB SURFACE AFTER SURFACE PREPARATION. EXPECTED AVERAGE OVERLAY THICKNESS IS 2". IF EXPECTED AVERAGE OVERLAY THICKNESS IS EXCEEDED BY MORE THAN 1/2", CONTACT STRUCTURES DESIGN SECTION. ESTIMATED FINAL GRADE RAISED OVER EXISTING CONDITIONS IS ESTIMATED TO BE 1/2".

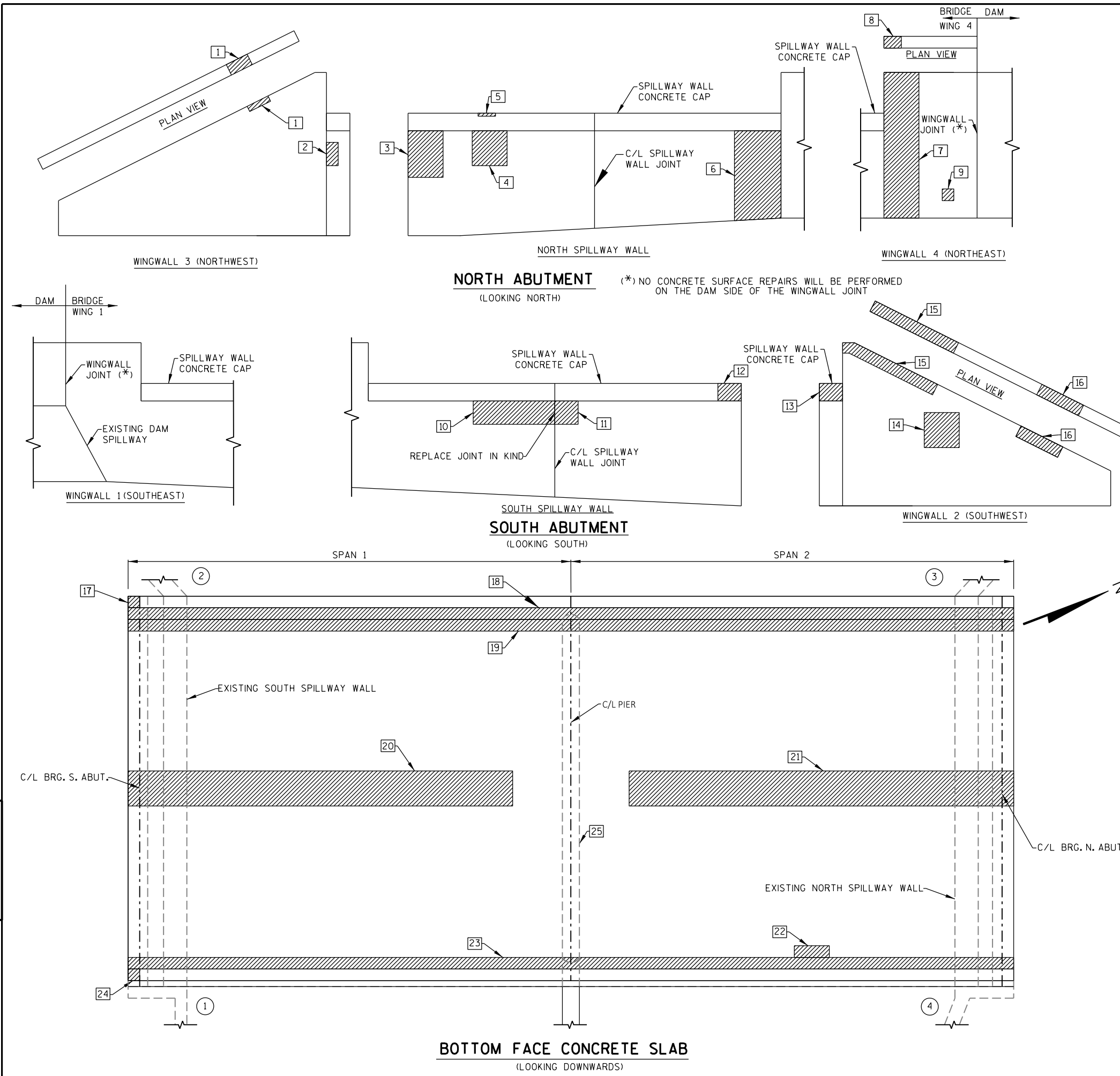

SEAL CRACKS ON THE EXPOSED FACES OF BOTH SPILLWAY WALLS AND WINGWALLS AS DIRECTED BY THE ENGINEER UNDER BID ITEM "EPOXY CRACK SEALING".

RE-CAULK EXISTING FLASHING ONCE THE PROTECTIVE SURFACE TREATMENT RESEAL IS APPLIED. RE-CAULKING EXISTING FLASHING IS INCIDENTAL TO "PROTECTIVE SURFACE TREATMENT RESEAL".
