ISSUE: The xml is not importing information, too much information in the xml, xml not formatted properly, or PDF document exported but will not open.

RESOLUTION: When setting up TraCS Task 3-14, *following the directions is crucial*. There are two settings in transmission



1.Import/Export is how to format the file and what files are to be sent to the RMS

2.Communication is where to put the file and how to send them.

Changing the path in the Import/Export area is **incorrect**.
