# Cannot get the Window Service for Batch Transmission to start

### **Problem:**

The following error message is received (your path may be different):

"An error occurred during startup. The ImportExport settings file, P:\TraCS10\TraCS\Settings\ImportExport.set.exml, does not exist or the current user does not have rights to access the file."

This is because this service only uses UNC naming conventions not drive letter mapping.

#### **Resolution:**

Remove all drive letter mapping in TraCS 10. To use redo the following:

- 1. Redo Task 1-2a steps 10 through 27 from the Installation Guide.
  - a. In step 23 put the UNC file path, do not use drive letter mapping.
- 2. Redo all import/export and communication settings.
  - a. Remove all drive letter mappings and change to UNC file path naming convention.
  - b. Tasks 3-10 through 3-14.

#### **Problem:**

The following error message is received:

"Windows could not start the TraCS Batch TransComm service on Local computer. Error 1067: the Process terminated unexpectedly."

This is because you either do not have the correct password set up in the schedule or you have not set up a schedule for Batch transmission.

## **Resolution:**

- 1. Complete Task 3-24.
- 2. Complete Task 3-25.
