## **TIME System Tribal License Plate Query Guidance**

Queries through WisDOT:

- Results → plate holder information excluding expiration data
- Inquiry by VIN → vehicle & owner information
- Oneida tribal license plates → returns a standard WisDOT response

Tribal license plates require two queries to determine the registration and the stolen status of the vehicle or license plate(s).

## **To obtain Wisconsin registration information:**

• Run a standard Wisconsin vehicle query (0173)

**License Plate:** [enter the license plate information]

**Type:** [enter the TB (Tribal) or leave blank]

**Year:** [enter the appropriate year]

## To obtain Out-of-State registration information:

• Run an Out-of-State vehicle query (0170)

**Destination State:** [enter the appropriate state] **License Plate:** [enter the license plate information] **State:** [enter the appropriate Tribal Nation code]

**Type:** [enter the vehicle type] **Year:** [enter the appropriate year]

• Additional information may be available from each state's help file

**To obtain NCIC responses**, including stolen vehicles, a separate query (0174 - License Plate Only Query – CIB and NCIC) is required.

For eTIME Browser/S2S MACH, the second query requires a NLETS query using the appropriate region code. If the state is unknown, use "Region code for all states."

Steps for NCIC responses:

**NLETS:** [enter the appropriate region code]

**Registration Number:** [enter the license plate information]

**Type:** [enter the vehicle type] **Year:** [enter the appropriate year]
