

## Who is eligible?

- Any Wisconsin resident.


## Vehicles that qualify

- An automobile.
- A motor home (Annual registration only).
- A private truck, dual purpose motor home or dual-purpose farm truck that has a gross weight of 8,000 pounds or less.
- A farm truck that has a gross weight of 12,000 pounds or less.


## Things you should know

Collector special plates are not the same as Collector
Plates. Please refer to the Collector plate application MV2323
for collector plate information. Collector Special plates are issued to applicants whom have had a Collector Plate series issued to them. Collector Special plates are issued to a qualifying general transportation vehicle and are renewed annually.

- Collector Special plates cannot be personalized.
- Collector Special plates have the same sequence as the Collector plate. The first Collector Special plate will be the Collector number. Each Collector Special plate thereafter will be the Collector number and an alpha character.
- Collector Special plates cannot be issued with a disabled parking designation.
- Plates will be mailed 3-4 weeks after you receive the new Certificate of Registration.


## Fees Needed

- The one time $\$ 15$ issuance fee
- The annual registration fee, if your current plates expire within 3 months.


## Plates required in 2 days

- To legally operate your vehicle, you must display license plates within two business days of purchase.
- If you do not have current plates, you may apply with a 3rd party agent to obtain a temporary plate while your collector special license plate order is processed. An agent may charge a plate fee and/or service fee.


## How to apply

1. Complete and sign application.
» Give a complete description of the vehicle including your current Collector Plate Series number.
» Give owner information.
» Incomplete applications will be returned.
2. If the vehicle you wish to register with Collector Special plates is already titled in your name and is currently registered, send a copy of your Certificate of Registration.
3. If the vehicle is not titled in your name, send a completed title application (MV1 or MV11), assigned title and fees, including Collector Special registration fees.
4. Make check or money order payable to: Registration Fee Trust.
5. Mail all required items with signed application to:
