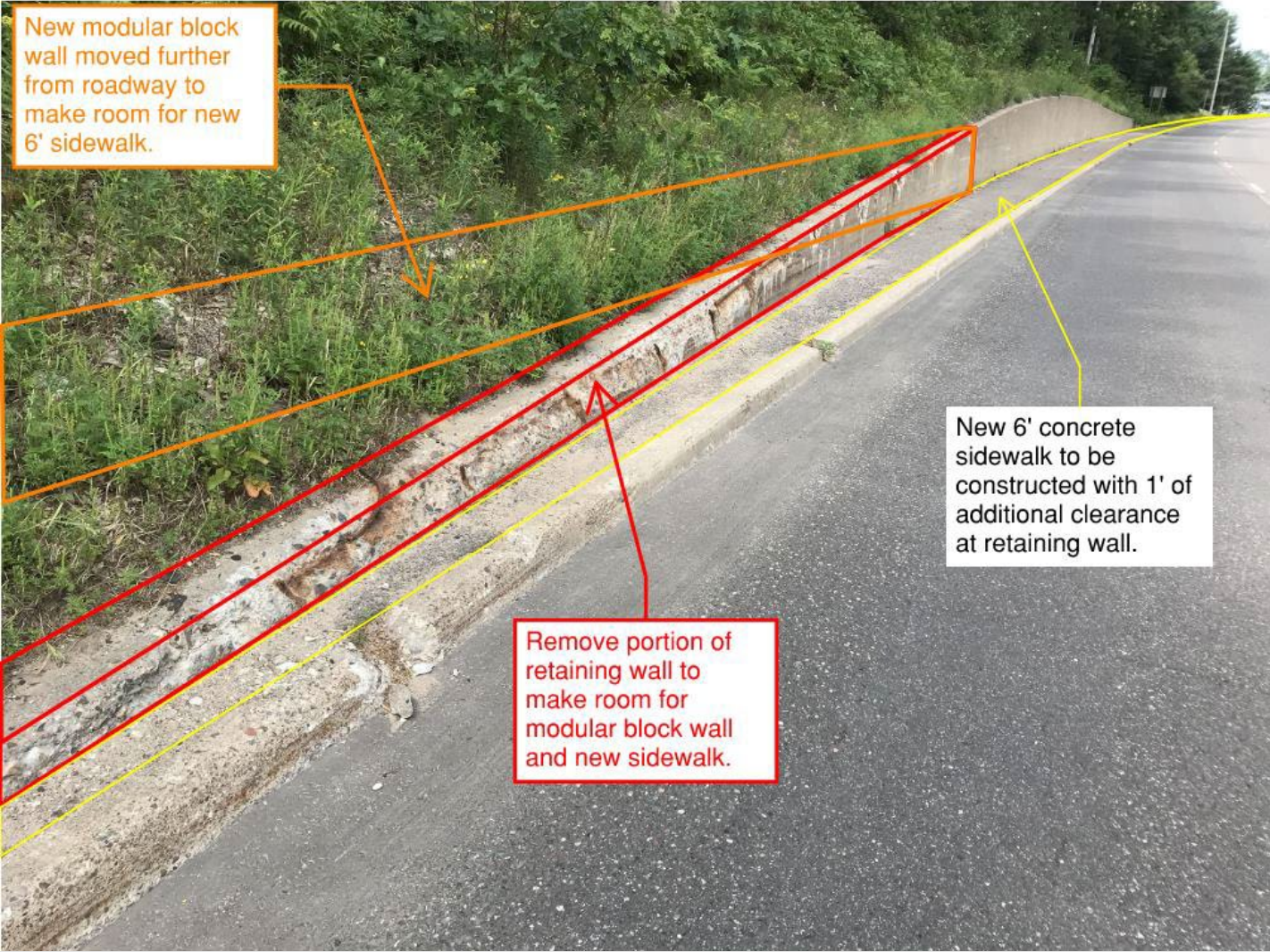

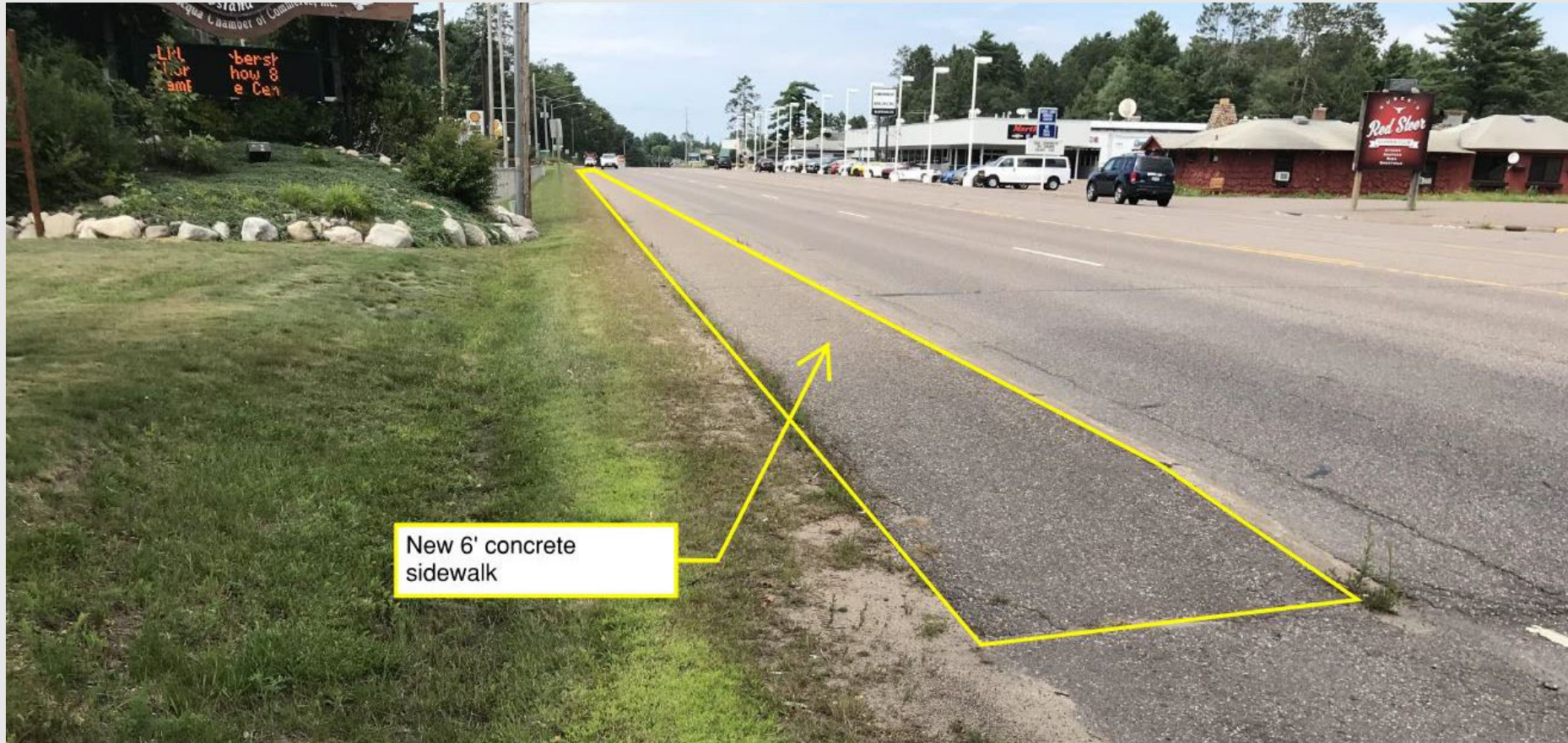
- The existing pavement is deteriorating, rutting, and cracking

Project Information

- Other identified needs within the project include:
 - Additional storm sewer inlets to capture storm water flow into the existing drainage pipe system
 - Existing sidewalk between Country Club Road and the Minocqua Lake bridge to be replaced



Proposed Traffic Impacts

- US 51 will be open to traffic during construction
 - Traffic will be reduced to a single lane in each direction throughout construction
 - Occasional flagging operations may be needed
 - Temporary driveway closures will be necessary during parts of the construction process. The contractor will contact homeowners and businesses in advance before closing a driveway.



Real Estate

- Additional right of way will be required for this project.
- This will include small areas of permanent (fee) and temporary (temporary limited easement) land acquisitions at some of the curb ramp and sidewalk locations along the east side of US 51.
- The impacts are not anticipated to impede or affect the existing use of the adjacent properties.



Project Update/Next Steps

- Local officials meeting was held July 20, 2021
- Final environmental document: Fall 2021
- Final Plans: Fall 2023
- Construction: Summer 2024
