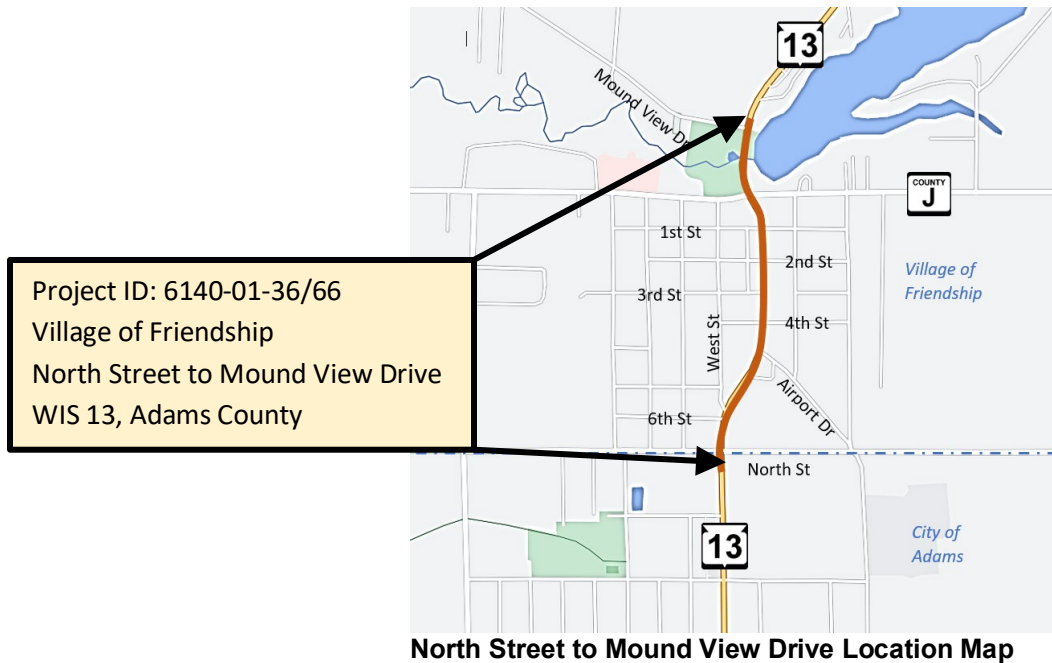

Purpose

The objective of this public involvement is to discuss the purpose and the need for the project and to obtain your feedback on the proposed improvements. A meeting with local officials was held on January 26, 2022.

Project Information

We are proposing to improve 0.67 miles of WIS 13 (Main St.)



The WIS 13 pavement is showing signs of deterioration. The pavement was originally constructed in the early 1990's.

Needs identified along this section of WIS 13 include:

- Deteriorating pavement, particularly at the joints
- Deteriorating sections of curb and gutter
- Existing curb ramps do not meet current ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) standards
- Storm sewer inlets are deteriorating and need of rehabilitation

Proposed improvements include:

- Remove the concrete pavement surface, patch deteriorated areas and overlay with asphalt
- Replace sections of deteriorated curb and gutter
- Upgrade curb ramps to meet current ADA standards
- Repair storm sewer inlets
- Install new pavement marking
- Construct new curb ramps and crosswalk at Mound View Drive

The WIS 13 bridge over Little Roche a Cri Creek , which was rehabilitated in 2021, is not included in this project.

WisDOT is considering construction of minor modifications to intersections including bump-outs (curb extensions for crosswalk safety modifications, shortening the crossing distance and improving visibility of drivers and pedestrians for each other) in the downtown area. These modifications will

allow for more fully meeting ADA curb ramp construction standards. In addition, bump-outs calm traffic and improve safety for pedestrians and will also result in reduced real estate impacts and impacts to nearby steps and building entrances compared to reconstructing the existing ramps in place.

Proposed traffic impacts

Construction is currently scheduled to begin in 2026 but could be begin as early as 2024.

During construction, WIS 13 will remain open to through traffic during construction. Motorists can expect to encounter daily flagging operations during construction. A temporary signal may be required between County J and Mound View Drive.

Access to adjacent properties will be maintained during construction. Brief interruptions in access may occur temporarily at driveways. The contractor will be required to notify homeowners and businesses prior to construction.

Real estate

Additional right of way will be required for this project. This consists of both permanent right of way and temporary easements at the intersections to accommodate the installation of new curb ramps to meet ADA standards. No other real estate is anticipated elsewhere on the corridor. Preliminary right of way impacts are shown on the exhibits available on the project website. WisDOT expects to begin real estate acquisition in Summer, 2022.
