
Purpose of Public Involvement

Project Location



















Project Purpose

 Preserve the roadway asset and minimize the overall life cycle cost of the corridor





Project Need

- Preventing un-serviceable pavement
- Curb ramps do not meet Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards





Project Information

- Proposed improvements to 4.5 miles of WIS 13 consist of the following:
 - Removing the top layer of the existing pavement surface and replacing it with a new surface of Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement.
 - Upgrade curb ramps to meet ADA standards
 - Replace existing pavement markings
 - Install new centerline and shoulder rumble strips














Proposed Traffic Impacts

- Through the two-lane rural segments, WIS 13 will remain open to traffic under flagging operations
- Through the three-lane and four-lane rural and urban segments, single lanes will be closed for construction while at least one lane in each direction remains open to traffic
- Traffic may be reduced to one lane on side roads when construction operations are occurring within the intersection





Proposed Traffic Impacts

- Staged construction of the new curb ramps and the use of temporary sidewalks and crosswalks will be provided while curb ramps are under construction
- Local and emergency access will be maintained to all businesses and residences during construction





Real Estate

- Additional right of way will be required for this project
- Minor temporary easements are needed for the curb ramp upgrades
- Preliminary right of way impacts are shown on the maps available on the project website
- WisDOT expects to begin real estate acquisition in winter 2022
 - Individual property owner meetings will be held
 - Landowner rights brochure is available on the project website





Project Update/Next Steps

- Preliminary design and plans: Fall 2021
- Right of way acquisition: Winter 2022 to Winter 2023
- Final plans: Fall 2022
- Construction is currently scheduled to begin in 2024 but could occur as early as 2023
