

Project Location





Project Information


- WisDOT proposing to reconstruct the intersection of WIS 23 with WIS 73/Pye Alley Road east of Princeton
- Limits 0.25 miles west of WIS 73 intersection to 0.25 miles east of WIS 73 intersection
- Purpose and Need
 - Intersection identified as a safety concern based on recent crash data
 - Lack of a dedicated left turn lane on WIS 23 appears to create a hazardous situation for motorists turning left from WIS 23 onto WIS 73



Project Information

Proposed Improvement

 Widen the south side of WIS 23 to add left turn lanes to improve the safety of the intersection





Proposed Traffic Impacts

- Roadways to remain open to traffic during construction using flagging operations
- Short term closures at intersection possible
- Some delays likely
- Local and emergency access will be maintained



Real Estate

- Majority of work will occur within existing highway right-of-way
- Some right-of-way acquisition required along south side of WIS 23 from 3 parcels
- Temporary easement required from 1 parcel
- Acquisition process
 - WisDOT will acquire real estate
 - Real Estate staff will coordinate with property owners
 - Acquisition expected to begin in mid 2022
- Landowner rights information available on the project website
