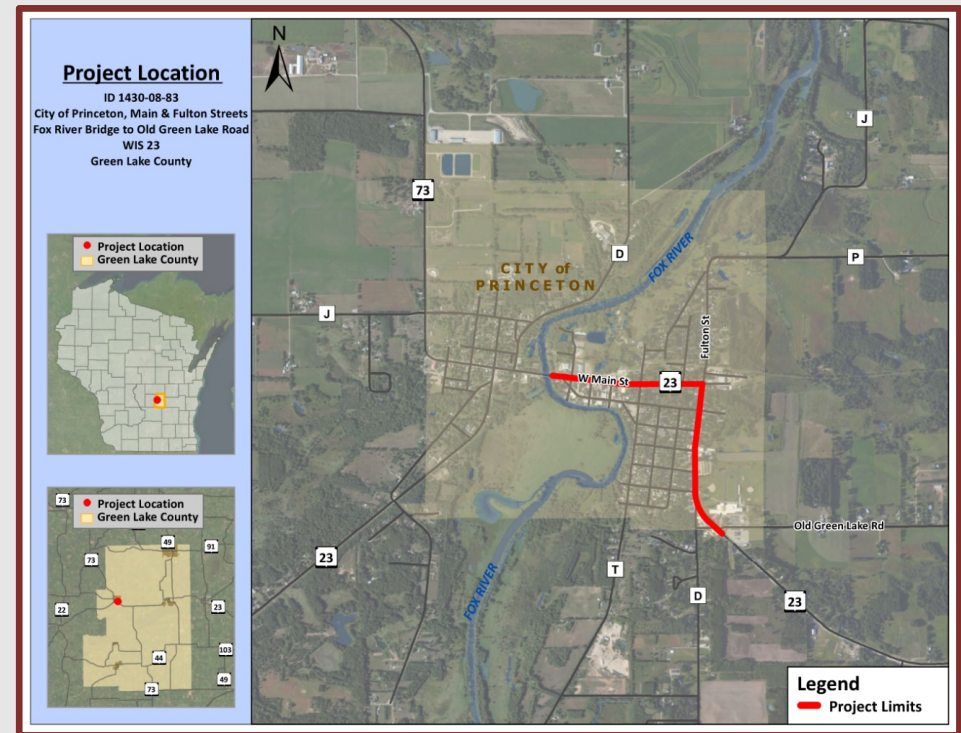

Purpose and Need

- Purpose

- Address pavement and curb ramps along WIS 23 through Princeton

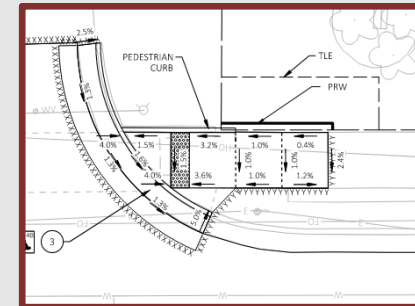
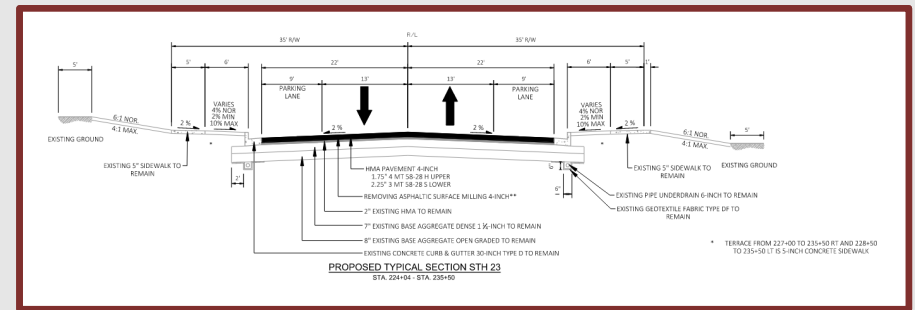
- Need

- Existing pavement is showing signs of deterioration
- Some existing curb ramps do not meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards



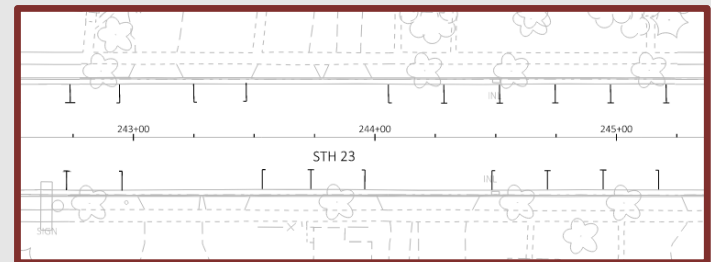
Proposed Improvements

- Roadway
 - Resurface WIS 23 by milling and overlaying the existing asphalt pavement
- Curb Ramps
 - Upgrade existing curb ramps to meet current ADA standards as feasible



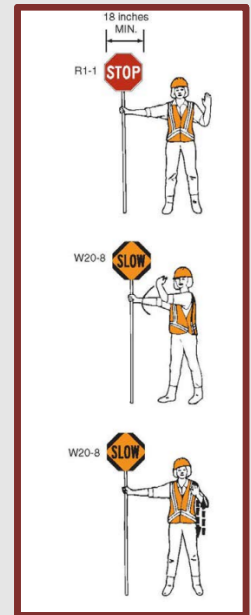
Proposed Improvements

- Parking Updates
 - Improvements to be determined by the city of Princeton and may include:
 - Update number and location of parking stalls based on current standards
 - New parking stall pavement markings



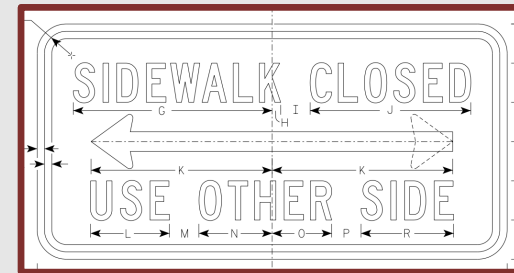
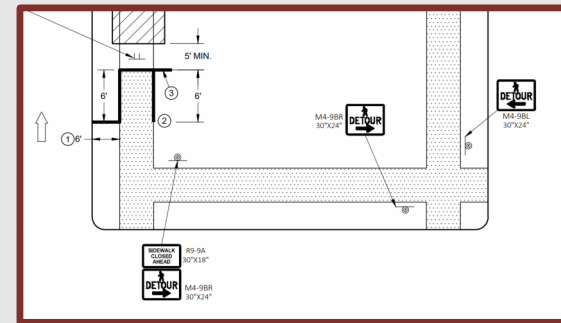
Traffic Control / Traffic Impacts

- Construction
 - Currently scheduled for 2028
 - As early as 2027 if funding becomes available
- Staging
 - WIS 23 to remain open to traffic throughout construction
 - Flagging operations and shoulder/parking closures to be used



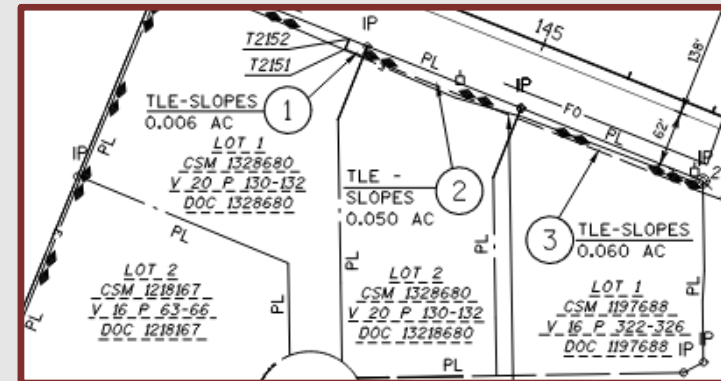
Traffic Control / Traffic Impacts

- Pedestrian accommodation
 - Curb ramp construction to be staggered to allow continued access
 - Temporary crosswalks or pedestrian detours to be used where necessary



Real Estate

- Acquisitions
 - Permanent right of way and temporary limited easements are needed for upgrades to curb ramps and sidewalk
 - The real estate acquisition process is anticipated to begin in 2024



Schedule

- Environmental Document Completion March 2024
- Preliminary Plan Submittal March 2024
- Real Estate Acquisition May 2024 – May 2026
- Final Plan Submittal May 2026
- Construction (as early as) 2027
- Construction (currently scheduled) 2028
