The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is in the process of developing plans for proposed improvements on 4.59 miles of WIS 42 in Manitowoc County. The purpose of this handout is to provide information regarding the proposed improvements, describe the potential impacts it would have on the community, and offer an opportunity for public comment.

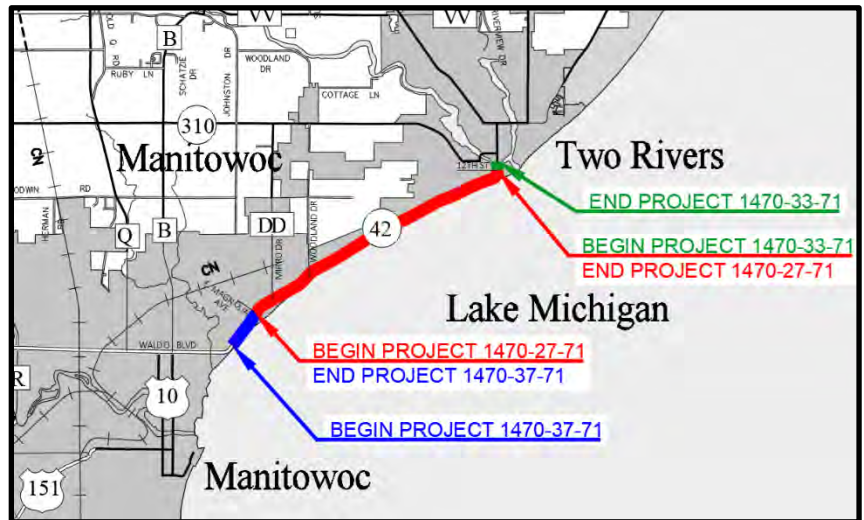
Project location

WIS 42 from Waldo Blvd in city of Manitowoc to the West Twin River Bridge in city of Two Rivers in Manitowoc County.

Project purpose and need

The purpose of the project is to extend the service life and improve the riding surface of WIS 42. Currently, the existing pavement is showing signs of deterioration. The existing beam guard has reached the end of its useful life and the metal pipes under the highway are deteriorating. The bridge over the West Twin River needs deck

maintenance to extend the structure's life. Mirro Drive intersection realignment is needed to bring the intersection closer to a 90-degree angle.



Anticipated benefits

Resurfacing will provide a smoother ride for motorists, extend the life of the pavement, and decrease future maintenance costs. Culvert repairs/replacements will help ensure proper drainage and lessen the likelihood of collapse. Beam guard upgrades will provide a greater level of safety should impact occur.

Proposed improvements

This is a resurface-level project. Proposed improvements include:

- Mill two inches of the existing surface and pave two inches of hot mix asphalt
- Concrete Bridge Deck Overlay (West Twin River Bridge)
- Culvert replacement and cleaning
- New curb ramps

- Beam guard replacement
- Mirro Drive intersection realignment (closer to 90 degrees)
- Pavement marking

Traffic impacts

WIS 42 will be closed for approximately one month during the concrete bridge deck overlay and culvert replacements. Detour will follow County Road Q and WIS 310. WIS 42 will remain open to traffic for paving with lane closures and flagging operations.

- Note: Access to properties and business will remain at all times.

Schedule

- Public Involvement December 2022
- Environmental document January 2023
- Real Estate Acquisition Begins Spring 2023
- Final Plans November 2024
- Construction currently scheduled Spring/Summer 2025

Real estate

Permanent (FEE) acquisition will be required on WIS 42 at Mirro Drive for realignment of the intersection. Additional permanent (FEE) and temporary (TLE) acquisition is anticipated for culvert work and curb ramps improvements. If your property will be impacted by this project, a member of our real estate department will contact you.

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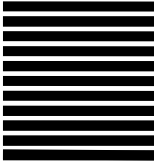
