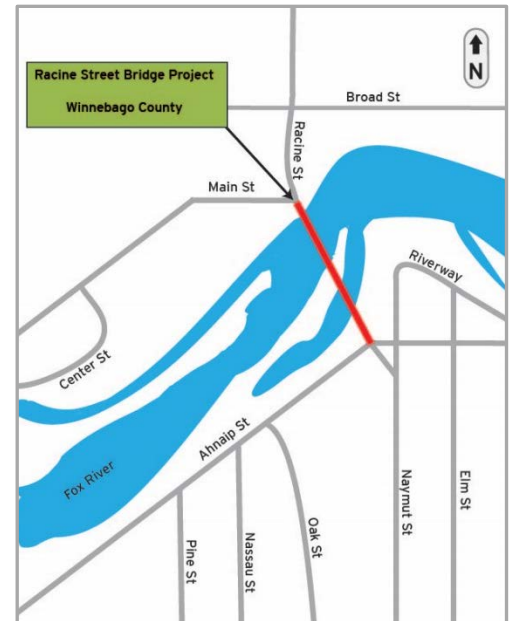
Welcome to this evening's meeting! Thank you for taking time to attend and learn more about the project.

Project Information

- The Racine Street Bridge was constructed in 1952 and is nearing its service life. While the bridge continues to be safe for use by the traveling public, it is in need of replacement or rehabilitation. This project requires an environmental study to document deficiencies in the bridge, develop alternatives for its replacement or rehabilitation, and evaluate the alternatives' impacts on the natural, physical, social and economic environments.

Meeting Purpose

- The purpose of today's meeting is to provide an update on design progress since the public involvement meeting (PIM) last fall, including a screening of the various improvement alternatives and preparation of a draft "Intersection Control Evaluation" (ICE). The Wisconsin Department of Transportation is soliciting feedback on the ICE alternatives prior to finalizing that document as they move toward selecting a preferred alternative.
