# **Purpose**

Our objective is to update you on the project scope and schedule and obtain your input on the identified needs, proposed improvements, traffic impacts and real estate needs along US 10 between Hunt Lane west of Eleva and Nelson Road on the west side of Osseo, all in Trempealeau County.

A meeting with local officials was held on Jan.18, 2023.

The purpose of the project is to preserve the roadway asset and minimize the overall life cycle cost of the corridor. Additionally, drainage, Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) compliance and roadside safety needs will be addressed.

Other identified issues include:

- Pedestrian curb ramps do not meet current ADA standards.
- Culvert ends are separated and leading to poor drainage.
- Run-off-the-road crashes are occurring along the corridor.

# **Project Information**

We are proposing to resurface approximately 13.3 miles of existing pavement with new asphalt at a depth of 3.25 inches along US 10.

PROJECT LOCATION

Other proposed improvements include:

- Widening paved shoulders.
- Adding centerline and shoulder rumble strips.
- Adjusting and/or replacing guardrail sections.
- Upgrading curb ramps to meet ADA standards.
- Improving culverts and adjacent ditches.
- Repairing or replacing culverts.

# **Proposed traffic impacts**

Construction is currently scheduled for the summer of 2025 and estimated to take four months to complete.

During construction, US 10 will remain open to traffic, but motorists will encounter single-lane and shoulder closures.

Local, business and emergency access will be maintained. However, temporary driveway closures will be necessary during parts of the construction process. WisDOT will contact homeowners and businesses in advance before closing a driveway.

### Real estate

No permanent real estate acquisition needs are expected; however, WisDOT will need temporary use at various locations for proposed curb ramp improvements and associated grading and minor regrading at culvert ends to remove culverts from adjacent properties through temporary limited easements.

### **Access Modifications**

No driveway access modification along the project is planned at this time.
