PROJECT OVERVIEW

LAKE DRIVE (WIS 32)

LIMITS: EDGEWOOD AVENUE TO KENSINGTON BOULEVARD

LENGTH: 1.3 MILES

REASONS FOR THE PROJECT

- ADDRESS DETERIORATING PAVEMENT CONDITIONS
- IMPROVE BICYCLE & PEDESTRIAN ACCOMMODATIONS
- REPLACE AGING MUNICIPAL UNDERGROUND FACILITIES

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

- PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT
- CURB & GUTTER REPLACEMENT
- CURB RAMP IMPROVEMENTS
- ADD BICYCLE LANES
- REPLACE TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT CAPITOL DRIVE
- UPGRADE STREET LIGHTING
- VILLAGE FUNDED UTILITY IMPROVEMENTS

CONSTRUCTION COST ESTIMATE

- \$8M TO \$9M
- COST SHARE AGREEMENT
 - DRIVING LANES PAID BY FEDERAL/STATE FUNDS
 - PARKING LANES PAID BY VILLAGE FUNDS






PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE

NORTH & SOUTH SEGMENTS

- JARVIS STREET TO KENSINGTON BOULEVARD
- EDGEWOOD AVENUE TO SHOREWOOD BOULEVARD
 - Buffered 5-Foot Bike Lane (Parking at Curb)






PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE

NORTH & SOUTH SEGMENTS


- BUFFERED 5-FOOT BIKE LANE (PARKING AT CURB)
 - 11-foot vehicular lanes
 - 5-foot bicycle lanes
 - 2-foot buffered protection separating bicyclists & vehicular traffic
 - Bike lane located between northbound vehicular lane and parking lane
 - 8-foot parking lane along northbound curb
 - No parking along southbound curb



PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE

CAPITOL DRIVE INTERSECTION SEGMENT

 SHOREWOOD BOULEVARD TO APPROXIMATELY 500-FEET NORTH OF CAPITOL DRIVE






PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE

CAPITOL DRIVE INTERSECTION SEGMENT


- SHOREWOOD BOULEVARD TO CAPITOL DRIVE
 - Shared roadway
 - 11-foot vehicular lanes
 - Two southbound lanes
 - One northbound left-turn lane
 - One northbound through lane



PREFERRED ALTERNATIVE

CAPITOL DRIVE INTERSECTION SEGMENT

- CAPITOL DRIVE TO APPROXIMATELY 500-FEET NORTH OF CAPITOL DRIVE
 - Shared roadway
 - Two 11-foot southbound lanes
 - One 14-foot northbound through lane
 - One 8-foot northbound parking lane



PEDESTRIAN SAFETY ENHANCEMENTS

- ADA CURB RAMPS AT ALL INTERSECTIONS
- EAST-WEST CROSSWALKS
- HIGH VISIBILITY MARKINGS
- CURB EXTENSIONS (BUMP-OUTS)
 - 5 locations
 - Edgewood Avenue
 - Menlo Boulevard with RRFBs (1)
 - Jarvis Street with RRFBs (2)
 - Olive Street
 - Kensington Boulevard





EDGEWOOD AVENUE

- Curb extension
- Flexibility to transition between Milwaukee & Village typical sections










MENLO BOULEVARD

- Curb extension
- Rectangular Rapid
 Flashing Beacons (RRFBs)
 1 set
- Leads to Nature Preserve
- ~Halfway between Edgewood Avenue & Capitol Drive
- Recommended in Village's Transportation & Parking Analysis from January 2020
- Northern crossing not proposed due to driveway









JARVIS STREET

- Curb extension
- Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) – 2 sets
- Located at Atwater Park
- Recommended in Village's Transportation & Parking Analysis from January 2020










OLIVE STREET

- Curb extension
- Near Atwater Park
- Southern crossing not proposed due to tree












KENSINGTON BOULEVARD

- Curb extension
- Transition between Village & Whitefish Bay typical sections
- Northern crossing not proposed due to driveway






MOST EXISTING SIDEWALK WILL REMAIN

MINOR SIDEWALK REPLACEMENT

- Curb ramps
- Driveways
- Sewer/water laterals
- Atwater Park









ADA PARKING STALLS

- Two on-street near Atwater Park
- Recommended in Village's Transportation & Parking Analysis from January 2020





DRAINAGE

- Inlets to be replaced with catch basins
- Clay drainage laterals to be replaced

SEWER/WATER REPLACEMENTS

- Combined sewer (south of Newton Avenue)
- 6,565 LF water main
- Service laterals

STREET LIGHTING

- New wire in conduit
- New poles with LED luminaires

TRAFFIC SIGNAL REPLACEMENT

- Capitol Drive intersection
- Prevent knock-downs in NW corner
- Monotube poles required
- Poles to be painted green






RIGHT OF WAY

- No relocations
- Driveway apron replacement
- 19 grading easements required
 - Sidewalk & curb ramps
 - Driveway matches

ENCROACHMENTS

- Special privilege permit items
 - Landscaping (stones, pavers, plants)
 - Irrigation
 - Security
 - Pet fences
- Homeowner is responsible for removing/replacing









2ND PUBLIC MEETING

HELD JUNE 21, 2022

PREVIOUS STAKEHOLDER RESPONSES

- MAJORITY SUPPORTED TREE PRESERVATION IN TERRACE
- MAJORITY OPPOSED TO PAVEMENT WIDENING

CONCLUSIONS

- ELIMINATED PAVEMENT WIDENING OPTIONS
- PRESERVE & PROTECT EXISTING TREES
- ELIMINATED REPLACE-IN-KIND ALTERNATIVE
- ELIMINATED PARKING FROM WEST SIDE OF LAKE DRIVE





2ND PUBLIC MEETING

RESPONSES RECEIVED

- 33 comments
- Parking removal
 - Five in favor
 - Two opposed
- Bicycle lanes
 - 29 in favor
 - One opposed
 - 19 asked for a protected bike lane
- Pedestrian safety enhancements
 - 21 in favor
 - Zero opposed
- Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs)
 - 17 in favor
 - · One opposed





NOVEMBER 7, 2022

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY ENHANCEMENTS

- CURB EXTENSIONS (BUMP-OUTS)
 - Occupy the parking lane
 - East side of the roadway
 - 5 locations (funded by WisDOT)
 - Edgewood Avenue
 - Menlo Boulevard
 - Jarvis Street
 - Olive Street
 - Kensington Boulevard

APPROVED 6-O BY VILLAGE BOARD






NOVEMBER 7, 2022

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY ENHANCEMENTS

- **CROSSWALK LOCATIONS**
 - High Visibility Markings
 - Capitol Drive intersection (funded by WisDOT)
 - East-west crossings at curb extensions (funded by Village)
 - Traditional Markings
 - At remaining north-south crossings (funded by Village)

APPROVED 6-0 BY VILLAGE BOARD





NOVEMBER 7, 2022

PEDESTRIAN SAFETY ENHANCEMENTS

- RECTANGULAR RAPID FLASHING BEACONS (RRFBS)
 - Need to be at marked crossings (funded by Village)
 - Village's Transportation & Parking Analysis from January 2020 recommended 2 locations
 - Menlo Boulevard
 - Jarvis Street
 - APPROVED 6-O BY VILLAGE BOARD





NOVEMBER 7, 2022

CONSTRUCTION YEAR

 Scheduled for 2025 to assist Village with planning and constructing Village projects by selecting a definitive construction year




ROADWAY TYPICAL SECTION OPTIONS

- STANDARD BICYCLE LANES (PARKING AT CURB)
 - Bike lane located between northbound vehicular lane and parking lane



DEFERRED 5-1 TO NOVEMBER 21ST MEETING

- PARKING PROTECTED BICYCLE LANES (BIKE LANE AT CURB)
 - Parking located between northbound vehicular lane and bike lane





ROADWAY TYPICAL SECTION OPTIONS

- PARKING PROTECTED BICYCLE LANES (BIKE LANE AT CURB
 - Recommended by the Parks and Public Spaces Committee meeting held November 15, 2022
 - Similar to City of Milwaukee proposal



CONCERNS NOTED BY VILLAGE'S POLICE. PUBLIC WORKS & PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENTS

- Visibility for all users at driveways
- Further reduction in parking at driveways to improve visibility
- Police officers standing in the vehicular lane while issuing tickets
- Non-standard parking location's impact on refuse, recycling, yard waste, leaf, and brush collection
- Non-standard parking location's impact on snow plowing operations
- Confusion about using a non-standard parking location
- Expectations of enforcement with limited staffing






NOVEMBER 21, 2022

 - Bike lane located between northbound vehicular lane and parking lane
 - Parking along northbound curb
