Introduction

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation is evaluating alternatives to improve safety for pedestrians and structures below the Hoan Bridge (I-794). The bridge crosses Harbor Drive, the Kinnickinnic River, Summerfest grounds, Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD), and the Port of Milwaukee located in the City of Milwaukee in Milwaukee County. The Bridge was opened in 1977 with a length of 1.9-mile that carries I-794 over the Kinnickinnic River, connecting I-794 (an auxiliary route of I-94) in downtown Milwaukee to the Lake Freeway on the south side of the river and has AADT (2020) of 35,800. The objective of this meeting is to obtain your input on the identified needs and proposed improvements.

Project Purpose and Need

The purpose of the proposed project of the Daniel Hoan Memorial Bridge (Hoan Bridge), I-794 crossing Harbor Drive, the Kinnickinnic River, Summerfest grounds, Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD), and the Port of Milwaukee, located in the City of Milwaukee is to address safety concerns resulting from debris (such as snow, ice, tires and auto parts, and trash) falling from the bridge down below and to limit access to the railing. Located beneath the Hoan Bridge is the Summerfest grounds, Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District (MMSD), and the Port of Milwaukee. Falling debris could result in worker and pedestrian safety concerns such as people below the bridge getting injured as well as property being damaged. Summerfest is one of the largest music festivals that hosts over 800 bands and 900,000 fans each year. MMSD is a regional government agency that provides water reclamation and flood management services. MMSD has reported at least 30 safety incidents in 2018 to 2019.

Structure Improvement

The improvement includes a 6-foot back-mounted chain link fence installation along the Hoan Bridge. The proposed fence would help prevent debris from falling from the bridge which could pose a safety risk. The fencing will also limit access for persons that attempt to get to the edge of the bridge structure.

Why a 6-Foot Tall Fence?

The department uses a snooper truck to perform structure inspections to ensure that the bridge is in good working condition. Six feet is the maximum height that the fence can be to allow snooper truck access.





Construction Staging

- Construction begins early summer 2023.
- The construction will be long term work utilizing outside shoulder closure during the day.
- Outside lane closures will be used during the night as permitted.
- The project construction is anticipated to last for 4 months.

Real estate

Acquisition of real estate is not anticipated for the project. Work is anticipated to occur within the existing right of way.
