

# Project Overview



















Existing pavement has reached the end of its useful life.
























 Safety improvement needs identified at Schumacher/Raemisch Road

















Operational improvements are needed at Division Street




















 Existing curb ramps at Division Street do not meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards























Existing culverts are in poor condition





















Storm water management changes needed at structure



























- Reconstruction
  - Add 14' raised center median
  - Reconstruct pavement structure
  - Storm sewer / drainage improvements






















- Mill and Overlay
  - Mill existing asphalt surface and add new asphaltic pavement
  - Add centerline and shoulder rumble strips

















- Division Street Intersection
  - Eastbound add dedicated left turn lane and extend right turn lane
  - Westbound extend the left turn lane and add a dedicated right turn lane
  - Reconstruct curb ramps to meet current ADA standards
  - New traffic signals
  - North leg reconstruction by others in 2023





















- Schumacher Road and Raemisch Road Intersection
  - Extend eastbound right and left turn lanes
  - Extend westbound right and left turn lanes
  - Offset WIS 19 left turn lanes for better visibility
  - New traffic signals




















- Replace, reset, or regrade select culverts
- Temporary and permanent real estate impacts















- New storm sewer inlets east of bridge
- Repaint bridge rail on structure over Six Mile Creek





















### Heritage Hills Development

- The third phase of the development will extend the north leg of the Division Street intersection.
- Work starting in 2022, finishing in 2023
- This construction is separate from the WisDOT WIS 19 project.


















## Heritage Hills Development

#### Section 4(f)

- Minor real estate impacts to Waunakee Village Park
- No anticipated impacts to Schumacher Farm County Park



















#### Concerns at Schumacher Farm Park

- Project scope and funding limitations
- No crash flags at this location
- WisDOT HSIP program





















## Preliminary Traffic Control

- Goal is for WIS 19 will remain open to traffic during construction.
- Mill and overlay operations will likely be conducted with flagging.
- The reconstruction portion of the project will likely be staged with one lane of traffic in each direction at all times.
- Access to residences and businesses will be maintained throughout construction.

- Public Involvement Meeting #1 May 2022
- Real Estate Process Begins Fall 2023
- Public Involvement Meeting #2 2024/2025
- Final Plans August 2025
- Construction Begins Spring 2026
