## The following changes to the TEOpS Manual have been made:

- TEOpS 2-15-51 Routine Sign Replacement Criteria (REVISED) changes represent the new practice of corridor replacement for Type II signs that was adopted last year. Language is also inserted to no longer require Type II signs to be replaced with every project.
- TEOpS 3-2-1 Longline Marking (REVISED) revised bike lane language and standard detail drawing references
- TEOpS 3-2-3 Special Marking (REVISED) updated crosswalk and parking restrictions language and standard detail drawing references
- TEOpS 3-2-4 Island Marking (REVISED) minor standard detail drawing reference update.
