Special Provisions

3. Prosecution and Progress

Remove entire section titled Interim and Final Completion of Work.

Replace entire section titled Interim Completion of Work Complete Stage 3 and Re-Open Entrance Ramps with the following:

Interim Completion of Work Complete Stage 3 and Re-Open Entrance Ramps

If the contractor fails to complete all work as shown in the plans from Stage 1A to Stage 3C and to open the northbound Entrance Ramp and southbound Entrance Ramp to traffic prior to 12:01 AM on September 30, 2020, the department will assess the contractor \$5,000 in interim liquidated damages per day for each calendar day after 12:01 AM on September 30, 2020, that this work is not complete. An entire calendar day will be charged for any period of time within a calendar day that the ramps remain closed beyond 12:01 AM, on September 30, 2020.

Insert the following section prior to section titled Enhance Liquidated Damages – Final Completion:

Interim Completion of Work Complete Stage 4

If the contractor fails to complete work (all permanent pavement and shoulders in their final configuration, traffic signals, signing, temporary striping, slopes graded to plan with BMPs and winter erosion control measures placed) as shown in the plans in Stage 4 and to open to traffic in its permanent configuration prior to 12:01 AM on November 15, 2020, the department will assess the contractor \$5,000 in interim liquidated damages per day for each calendar day after 12:01 AM on November 15, 2020, that this work is not complete. An entire calendar day will be charged for any period of time within a calendar day that the project is not substantially complete beyond 12:01 AM, on November 15, 2020.
