ADDENDUM NO. 01 1166-00-83 June 9, 2022

Special Provisions

3. Prosecution and Progress.

Replace entire article language with the following:

Begin work within 10 calendar days after the engineer issues a written notice to do so.

Provide the time frame for construction of the project within the 2022 construction season to the engineer in writing within a month after executing the contract but at least 14 calendar days before the preconstruction conference. Assure that the time frame is consistent with the contract completion time. Upon approval, the engineer will issue the notice to proceed within 10 calendar days before the beginning of the approved time frame.

To revise the time frame, submit a written request to the engineer at least two weeks before the beginning of the intended time frame. The engineer will approve or deny that request based on the conditions cited in the request and its effect on the department's scheduled resources.

Northern Long-eared Bat (Myotis septentrionalis)

Northern Long-eared Bats (NLEB) have the potential to inhabit the project limits because they roost in trees. Roosts may not have been observed on this project, but conditions to support the species exist. The species and all active roosts are protected by the Federal Endangered Species Act. If an individual bat or active roost is encountered during construction operations, stop work and notify the engineer and the WisDOT Regional Environmental Coordinator (REC).

According to the final 4(d) rule issued for the NLEB, the department has determined that the proposed activity may affect, but will not result in prohibited take of the NLEB. The activity involves tree removal but will not occur within 0.25 miles of a known hibernacula, nor will the activity remove a known maternity roost tree or any other tree within 150 feet of a known maternity roost tree.

If additional trees need to be removed, no Clearing shall occur without prior approval from the engineer, following coordination with the WisDOT REC. Additional tree removal beyond the area originally specified will require consultation with the United States Fish and Wildlife Service (USFWS) and may require a bat presence/absence survey. Notify the engineer if additional Clearing cannot be avoided to begin coordination with the WisDOT REC. The WisDOT REC will initiate consultation with the USFWS and determine if a survey is necessary.

Submit a schedule and description of Clearing operations with the ECIP 14 days prior to any Clearing operations. The department will determine, based on schedule and scope of work, what additional erosion control measures shall be implemented prior to the start of Clearing operations, and list those additional measures in the ECIP.

IH 39 lane and ramp closures have the following restrictions:

Lane closures are permitted during the following:

Monday to Thursday	12:00 AM to 11:59 PM
Friday	12:00 AM to 12:00 PM
Saturday	12:00 AM to 11:59 PM
Sunday	12:00 AM to 11:59 PM

Ramp closures for Stage 1 and Stage 3 to Stage 5 are permitted during the following times:

Monday to Thursday	12:00 AM to 6:00 AM 7:00 PM to 11:59 PM
Friday	12:00 AM to 6:00 AM
Saturday	Not Allowed
Sunday	9:00 PM to 11:59 PM

Ramp closures for Stage 2 are not allowed except for the continuous ramp closure of the IH 39 NB off ramp to STH 34.

General

For existing Type I signs designated in the plans to be moved or removed and replaced, perform the work required at each location within the same working day.

Stage 1: Construct STH 34 to IH 39 NB temporary on ramp.

Stage 2A: Remove concrete and asphalt pavement at the IH 39 NB and STH 34 intersection. Install asphalt pavement. Mill and overlay IH 39 NB ramps at STH 34 and STH 34 NB lane.

Stage 2B: Remove temporary ramp. Mill and overlay STH 34 SB lane.

Stage 3: Mill and overlay IH 39 NB passing lane.

Stage 4: Mill and overlay IH 39 NB driving lane, outside shoulder and IH 39 NB ramps at STH 153.

Stage 5: Install grooved pavement markings and rumble strips.

- -From noon Friday, May 26, 2023 to 6:00 AM Tuesday, May 30, 2023 Memorial Day;
- -From noon Friday, June 30, 2023 to 6:00 AM Wednesday, July 5, 2023 Independence Day;
- -From noon Friday, September 1, 2023 to 6:00 AM Tuesday, September 5, 2023 Labor Day;

6. Holiday and Special Event Work Restrictions.

Replace entire article language with the following:

Do not perform work on, nor haul materials of any kind along or across any portion of the highway carrying IH 39 and STH 34 traffic, and entirely clear the traveled way and shoulders of such portions of the highway of equipment, barricades, signs, lights, and any other material that might impede the free flow of traffic during the following holiday and special event periods:

- From noon Friday, July 1, 2022 to 6:00 AM Tuesday, July 5, 2022 for Independence Day;
- From noon Friday, September 2, 2022 to 6:00 AM Tuesday, September 6, 2022 for Labor Day;
- From noon Wednesday, November 23, 2022 to 6:00 AM Monday, November 28, 2022 for Thanksgiving Day.
